### December 31 2016

That is it for this year. Not much going on today. We picked up pills and some groceries. The snow is melting, so that is good for Monday golf. #### December 14 2016

Started slow today to make sure Mary was OK. She was. I fixed scrambled eggs and toast and went off to the Y. Told them she was OK and did 20min on the elliptical. Lots of aches and pains from strength class this morning. In the 20s today and expected to be in the teens tomorrow. Brrrr.

Did the wash and started a puzzle Carolyn brought. She brought us 4. Not much else doing. Watched some horse races and stock market stuff. This is looking like the year I profit and end the year with more than I started with even after the withdrawals. That would be a first.

### December 13 2016

We went to the strength class and Mary had to sit and then lay down the last 5 minutes. She was dizzy for around 10 minutes the puked. The Y called the paramedics to check her out and a nurse came over and stayed till they arrived. By the time they got there she was able to sit up. They did an ekg and took her vitals and they were OK so we went home. The Y staff was great.

Wes stopped over to check her out and gave her the thumbs up. She rested the remainder of the day. Had toast for dinner. She was kind of burping the rest of the night and took a pepto. Hope that helps.

I got her a dr appt Thursday, moved the car turn in to Friday, and canceled our trip to Pittsburgh for the concert. Must be a curse on that thing. We had to cancel 2 yrs ago when mom passed away and had to cancel again.

#### December 12 2016

Did 20min on elliptical and 20 on the treadmill today. Left foot was hurting so I cut it short. Did some reps on the 2 ab machines. ### December 11 2016

This month is whizzing by. Got up to 2" of light stuff. I pushed it off the driveway sometime after breakfast while getting the newspaper. Not allowed to shovel you know. Carolyn and Jenna stopped in for a bit during the news. Worked on the puzzle while like they were actually the Browns lose, and listening to the Bills lose to the Steelers.

Dabbled in the next puzzle. Mary has done about half so I will leave her the last 20% (trees). Turned out to be a nice sunny day. With the rain all day yesterday, I don't see how it could have been better than the last two times they were closed.

#### December 6 2016

Rained all day so I figure the golf course will be closed tomorrow. Last decent day before the snow flies this weekend. I went to the strength class today. Did OK except at the end. Leg bicycles on your back for 30 seconds plus other like ab exercises on your back. Can't do that very long. She causes me to laugh when I start doing something like this that is a struggle and she says just 30 seconds more. Mary went with Brenda to Alliance so she skipped these.

Did another puzzle last night and today. It was a hand me down that said all pieces. They lied. There was one missing. It was a hard one with pieces that fit in many directions instead of just n/s/e/w. Not ready for being shut in. Wish I could go to sleep and wake up in February. I had better find something else to do besides puzzles.

#### December 5 2016

No sun today either but it wast bad. Went to the Y and walked 1.2 mi with Mary then did the elliptical for 15min. Seemed tough today for some reason so I cut it short by 5min. I did 25 reps on the ab machine. Course was still closed with cold approaching. Very disappointing! Did a 300pc puzzle but it was done by 2pm.

Still have not listened to WNIR for even 1 minute since the election. Don't think I ever will. Paul Ryan on TV said he will be working with Trump Rump on things important to Americans. Too bad he didn't see fit to work with Obama the past 8 years on things important to us Americans.

#### December 4 2016

No sun today either but it was a little brighter. Worked on a new puzzle most of the day, Kaetchen called and invited us to the Evening in Hartville with the kids at dusk. Have to eat there again. We were going to do chinese but they were not open yet.

Wrapped the gifts put labels on the gifts. Mary did church as usual and I cooked the spaghetti. Jus have to pick up some gift cards and a gift for Sue and Mary. We will visit Sue the 14<sup>th</sup> so we will look around and see what she needs.

#### December 2 2016

Total bummer. We were going to play but they said it was closed. I don't think they are getting enough play to make it worthwhile. Mary and I went over to pick up the 2 piles of leaves I left yesterday. Took 15 min and we scared the crap out of her when she brought one of the dogs out. She is a riot.

*I puttered around doing some touch up painting and decorating, but basically was a veggie today. Mary went to knitting class and is knitting off and on. Winter sucks!* 

Oh yeah. Forgot to mention I came out of my chess slump the other day and amazed myself. I had dropped from 1250s to 1100 but finally rebounded to 1190. Hope I can get over the hump.

### December 1 2016

New month! Last one for this year. We went to strength class at the Y. Wasn't too bad. Told the instructor that when I started I could only do about 5 crunches. Now I can almost make it through the many she does in 2 or 3 sets. Got a puzzle out. No dr appts this month and most of the gift shopping is done so its veggie time.

Since we are playing tomorrow, I got on my winter golf gear and gave it a good test raking Brenda's lawn. Was out there close to 2 hrs and was plenty warm. Hope the wind stays down.

### November 30 2016

Warm but misty crumby day. Might be the last warm day. To the Y early. We walked 1.5 miles, then Mary went to yoga, and I did 20 on the elliptical and did the ab weight machine. Changed and got a haircut, got stamps, picked up prescription and groceries. After a shower, I got to all the rest of my outdoor flower clearing. I am whipped at 2pm.

### November 29 2016

Luckily the rain didn't pour last night so the course was open. Dick couldn't play due to some legal business. Mel was going to play but Joann was ailing this AM. It was Bill and I. I started off great with a 41 on the black with a short birdie putt on 7. Bill had 48 on the front. He bested me on the maroon with a 45 to my 48. I had 3 penalties and a few 3 putt green. Oh well. I hope to play again and wash away the memories of that ugly nine.

Mowed and raked when I got home. That was a chore. We put away the xmas boxes till January. Pretty much whipped.

### November 28 2016

We set up golf for noon but the radar looked bad this am. I went to strength training and warned Bill to check before he left. When I got back he had dropped out but the radar was breaking up. Dick and I teed off at 11:30 and flew aound in 2 ½hours. The fast play was good for me as I went 41-38 =79. Only the 2<sup>nd</sup> time I broke 80 this year I think. Birdied two of the easiest. An 18 inch putt on maroon 5, the short par 4, and a 10 footer on gold 6, a reachable par 5. Went even par the last 5 on the gold.

Not sure about tomorrow. Will depend how much rain we get. They have removed the tee markers and seem ready to close soon.

### November 27 2016

Up early and did pancakes from scratch since we had no mix. Catherine packed up

and headed back to Buffalo. We shall see her at Christmastime. Got right to getting the tree stuff out. Had the tree half decorated when Wes called. We slowed down and left the bottom half of the tree for the kids to decorate.

The kids helped but lost interest pretty soon so we were off to other things. Played outside in the gator garden, did the mermaid on the computer, this and that and other things too. Wes got them about darkness. He had been doing leaves all day. The kids had finished off the turkey, so we had the left over ribs for dinner.

Bills won again to get 1 game over .500. If they hold true to form they will lose next week.

#### November 26 2016

#### November 24 2016

I went after lunch and there were about 100. Tried a 3d time around 2:15 and it was down to 40. I waited 45 min and got it done.

Catherine arrived a little after I got home. We had dinner and next up is gift wrapping.

#### November 22 2016

We did the Y strength class at 10am. She said she was going to push us but it wasn't too bad. I have no problems anymore with the 3/5lb weights. I need to move to 3/8lb. I can only do 3lbs for the shoulders with the number of reps they usually call for. He curls are too easy with the 5lb.

We went to Beilers Market to get some rutabega but we picked up some other interesting items. Cut up and cooked it when we got home. The ones from Marcs were pretty bad and I think I put some of the woody pieces in the pot. I tasted some before it was totally mixed up and I got a woody chunk. Hopefully we mixed it enough to smooth it out.

Had to get new crackers for the cheese. The old ones had dec16 and mar15 expiration dates. Mary got her hair done. Dick was emailing me about golf but he doesn't have all the snow cover we have here. Will call the course tomorrow but I am not hopeful.

### November 21 2016

Did the Y today. Put in 20 on the elliptical, 20 on the treadmill, and did some tricep and ab weights. Freezing this morning. When I got back I pumped up all the tires on our cars and left the compressor out and did Carolyn's and Wes' car when they stopped in around noon. Cold cold cold!

Wes left Kalix here and she had a ball playing grocery shopping several times and doing a play tea party. Jenna was big on the tea parties back in the day. My side started to hurt when I took the rocker downstairs. Feels exactly like my gall bladder pain. Got to keep an eye on that. We shall see how it feels tomorrow before I go to strength class.

#### November 20 2016

John 84, Dick 86, Mel 96, and Bill lowest with an 81. I got 2 of John's dollars and one of Mel's quarters! We might get lucky Wednesday if the rain holds off otherwise it will be a no golf week.

Did a little leaf pickup before the crappy weather hits.

# October 31 2016

The 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary party for Mary's sister Ruth and Dennis was very nice. Dennis got a nice new driver from one of his brothers. I couldn't get out the door with it though. Back home around 2:30pm today.

Played Tammy Dales today and shot 41-42=83. I was striking the ball fairly well and my short game was a little better. Picked up a birdie with a nice chip and a 4 foot putt. Finally beat John. He went 39 on the front but faded on the back to 47. Bill shot 40 on the back which is wonderful for him.

Mary was doing some more spaghetti sauce and we went to Giant Eagle when she was done. We had to look at the new ankle biter wiener dog Brenda now has. Mary warned me to tighten up my belt. I did but not enough. They dropped while I was at the service desk so I must be on tape. No one was around thankfully. Hope that doesn't show up on the internet somewhere.

### August 25 2016

Another hot one. It hit 90 and you could feel it. Played Tammy Hills today and shot 42-42=84. I was striking the ball well but my short game was not up to it. Couple of 3 putts and a 4 putt chapped me. Missed 3 or 4 birdie tries. Playing the Dales tomorrow. Hope I do better around the greens.

Not much else was going on. Too hot to do much outside after golf.

### August 24 2016

We did the usual at the Y this morning. Mary had a bowling meeting then we did the fuel perks. We saved \$48 on 30 gallons of fuel. Sweet!

After dinner we watched the kiddies at their place. We watched Disney Jungle Book 1. It was done in 1967, almost 30 years ago. For some reason it just struck me that all the people doing the voices were already dead.

### <u>August 23 2016</u>

Another beautiful cool day. We were surprised early with a plant delivery this morning. We had to move some plants to put it into one of the pots, so that took more time. While we were out, Brenda had us take one of her plants so we had to replant that too. While we were at it, I trimmed up the bush. Glad Mary helped cause it was a lot of work. ### August 20 2016

Baby day. We got the call before 6am and Mary rushed over. Baby came quickly 8 something am. I went over around 7am to help with the kids. We got going to the little doughnut shop and back to our house to play. Then Mary took the kids up to see baby brother. They visited, went out to lunch, then back to visit and were there all day. Back to our house for a few hrs then we met Wes at his house. Mary got the kids in the bath and we dragged ourselves home. Quite a workout for Mary!

*I was home after the doughnuts and waited for Jacob to get over and mow my and Pete's lawn. He did a great job as usual.* 

### <u>August 19 2016</u>

<u>August 17 2016</u>

Jacob was going to be here early so I got up and got to the Y at 6:30 and was back before he got here. We made some cardboard stuff for Zander to play with.

He was way late due to mix ups with his medical papers for school. The XC guys said he was good to go but the school needed something else. He got over and cut Pete's late and then started mine. We were worried about the storm coming thru so he did the front first. Good thing, as the rains came when he was about ½ done.

As he was hightailing it back to the garage as it started pouring, he threw it into 5<sup>th</sup> gear and at first look, blew out the transmission. We had to lift the back wheels to push it to the driveway cause the wheels are locked up. The engine runs but it wont go into gear. I will give it a look tomorrow but I think it is toast.

It was not the course to play in the heat. No shade anywhere on the course. I played well but was toast the last 3 or 4 holes due to the heat. Went 42-43 for an 85. I had 5

birdie ops and made 1, lipped out on another, and 1 went right over the edge without even peeking in. Oh well.

John T called about tomorrow's golf. He told me he was out 2 weeks so I was not expecting him. # August 10 2016

Heading over to Wes' shortly. They are going to do the trivia again tonight. We will start the kids to bed and they should be there 8:45 ish.

# August 9 2016

Another hot one with 3 more scheduled this week. The dryer was dead last night when we tried to use it again. Turns out the thermal fuse AND thermal regulator need to be a matched pair and purchased in a kit. Apparently the old thermal fuse didn't match up with ths new thermal regulator I bought. Ordered the pair thru Walmart and temporarily shorted the fuse out so we could use the dryer till then. Just need to keep an eye on it.

Ordered a couple more plants we saw at Kingwood and puttered around the rest of the day. Happy Birthday Wes!

### August 8 2016

Very nice day. We played Pleasant View down Louisville way. We played the white at 5900 since the red tees were only 4900 yds. It was a long 5900 with some long uphill holes adding to the difficulty. I was hitting 4 and 5 irons all day long. Too many look ups doomed me to an 89. Never had a reasonable birdie chance.

I got back and Wes was on his way over. I had asked him when he was coming over for his birthday BLTs now that we have tomatoes on the vine. Guess today was the day. We played with the kids till 6 ish before they left. Mary is off to Red Hats.

Oh yeah, the dryer parts came and I fixed it so we can do wash again. I was a bit ticked as I paid extra for 2 day shipping that took 5 days. I ordered Wednesday thinking I would get it Friday. They didn't get it to Fed-ex till Thursday and the 2 day ship didn't include weekends. I complained and they basically said I must not have read the fine print.

### August 7 2016

Another comfortable day! Slept in till almost 7am. We were off to Mansfield by 8am to go to Kingwood Garden Center. We were the first ones there at 9:15am. ### <u>August 5 2016</u>

Went to the Y and did the usual again. Mary joined me. We went grocery shopping later around lunchtime. Too hot to do weeding. Tomorrow should be cooler. Maybe I can catch up.

### <u>August 4 2016</u>

Another hot one, made it to 90 again. We played Barberton Brookside. I had a bad time of it playing out of the trees and missing 2 short putts on the front 9 shooting 46. Birdied the first par 3 and took double par on the  $2^{nd}$ . Played better on the back with a par and bogy on the two par threes. The hole of the day was #18. I crushed a 250yd

drive and played a pitching wedge from 115 with the pin up front. It hit somewhere around the front and rolled up into the cup for an eagle 2.

Been a long time since I had an eagle in Garretsville. George was there. He said uh-oh as I chipped my 3d into the cup for an eagle on the par 5 with the green down by the bridge. Did a little gardening after dinner. Mary went over to visit Jake and Jenna while I was golfing.

# <u>August 3 2016</u>

Another hot one, made it to 90. We went to the Y. I did 15 on the elliptical and 25min on the treadmill. I get bored on the treadmill before 10min is gone but the TVs keep my interest and keep me going. Got pretty sweaty so I showered and headed to the retiree lunch.

Ken brought his dad to the lunch. He is still in hospice but switched to the one run by AGMC. His hand was shakey and he doesn't move his head very freely bit is still hanging in there. He was happy to get some more boost.

Mary said the dryer wasn't heating. She got me the model number and I found a great site showing the heater part number and even had a video on how to do it. We pulled the dryer apart and I removed the heat coil to check it. Sure enough it was broken. Looked like it was just brittle and broke. Ordered the part with 2 day delivery. Carolyn stopped over and brought me some cable clamps. Put those on as well. Productive day.

# <u>August 2 2016</u>

Another hot one. We went to HD and picked up a few things. I got 2 power strips and installed them to free up place to plug. Bought a 25 ft video cable to replace one that was a bit too short. Picked up a vent cover to go under the sink in the kitchen. It was a floor cover but it fit well. I pulled off some old coving, installed the vent cover and put some new coving in.

Also bought some Preen. I was getting a little tired of pulling weeds so I will see hoe this stuff works out. Spent a few hours sprinkling it around after I weeded. I would say I am about 1/3 done so there is a lot to still do.

### <u>August 1 2016</u>

Another hot one. I hacked around the front 9 at Goodpark missing every 5 ft putt I had to shoot 47. After two good pars on the back I went 6 of 7 pars for a 3 over 39 to salvage the round. Still did not hit many good shots but was getting it up and down around the greens.

Darrell played just short of 6 weeks from bypass surgery. I had to take a look back and found I waited to see the surgeon before I played so it was 7.5 weeks. He played well and was real happy to be playing again. Welcome back!

Still wondering about my leg. A week ago Saturday I had a large bump on my shin. Thought it was a ding. It has not gone away. Dick thinks it is a bug bite because of the large area it covers. If it continues to bother me I might have to see the doc.

Wes called and wanted to make sure Mary had her bag packed. Although Kaetchen is not due till Aug 24 she is thinking she will be 10 days earlier.

### July 31 2016

Slow morning. We walked the neighborhood at 8am and it was getting warm. Picked some weeds. Wes called and we found out the kids would be over soon around lunchtime. He brought spaghetti for all. We had a good time and he picked them up around 5pm I think.

*That is it for July. August is next and late this month is 1 yr bypass anniversary Aug 25.* 

# July 30 2016

Lots of aches and pains last night. They went away with the night's sleep. Was thinking of walking this am but radar was iffy on rain. Missed out as it never did rain. Watched the women's British Open all day. Got out and pulled 3 buckets of weeds. I figured 1 bucket a day is needed to keep up. Now I am not sure I didn't underestimate. Somehow I have to find a better way cause I can't be doing this down the road.

Got to cook the spaghetti tonight while Mary goes to church.

### July 29 2016t

Nice cloudy morning gave us a another break from the oppressive heat. Played Seven Hills and we finished by 11:30am. Had an up and down round going 44-47. All I needed was a bogey on 18 to shoot 89 fut I hit my 2<sup>nd</sup> on the edge of the lake. Tried to hit it out and just burred it into the mud. Ended up with a triple 7. The sun cleared and it got hot.

We went to the Uniontown festival at 6:30 and the kiddies had a ball. They must have run through this climbing/slide thing 20 times. The Open office spell check stopped working so I searched for Open Office and found where I fixed it before. Crazy.

### July 28 2016

Nice cloudy day gave us a little break from the oppressive heat. Played Mayfair with the Lockheed guys today. Did good shooting 43-41 for an 84. Missed at least 6 make able putts and not by much either. I could have been someone.

Grabbed a haircut and picked some weeds later. Likely go over to Brenda's at dusk and puff some poisen on her hornet nest. Mom's birthday today, Dad's yesterday RIP.

### July 27 2016

Another hot one. We went to the Y this morning. I did 15 on the elliptical and 30 on the treadmill. Mary did yoga. I tried a different elliptical today and it was a little harder than the others. Got my oil changed and car washed and picked up some groceries. Picked some weeds before it got too hot, then stayed in.

# July 26 2016

A little cooler today. Picked weeds today and watched the market. Not much doing these hot days. Did some reading on plantations in Georgetown and found a couple more interesting sites.

I was wondering what makes pee yellow as i was peeing today. From WebMD: Pee is your body's liquid waste, mainly made of water, salt, and chemicals called urea and uric acid. Your kidneys make it when they filter toxins and other bad stuff from your blood. If everything is normal and healthy, the color should be a pale yellow to gold. That hue comes from a pigment your body makes called urochrome.

Urobilin is generated from the degradation of heme, which is first degraded through <u>biliverdin</u> to <u>bilirubin</u>. Bilirubin is then excreted as bile, which is further degraded by microbes present in the large intestine to urobilinogen. Some of this remains in the large intestine, and its conversion to <u>stercobilin</u> gives <u>feces</u> its brown color. ### historic event!

Jacob was going to come over and cut grass but he didn't get here early enough and it became unbearably hot. I called it off and pushed it to next week. Pretty much watched golf all day. We finally got rain when a storm passed thru around 1pm.

I uploaded my golf scores to the scores page. That page was not working under Firefox but works under Chrome. I don't like using the Chrome browser as google tracks everything you do. I will use Chrome for the golf page but nothing more.

# July 23 2016

*Missed yesterday. Was too tired to work on it. We were up at 5:30 to get to Tanglewood for golf. I never got it going, playing from the trees all day due to slicing off the tee. Shot 95. George played well and was the champ for this year.* 

We then headed to Fowlers Mill and cooled down while having lunch. The were booked but their 3d nine was open. The heat really hit us when we went out. I didn't fare well nor did the others. Just too hot to play.

*I am going to stay out of the heat today for sure. The boys were up at 5:30am and off to Carolyn's to pick up Joe by 7am. Might see Jacob for mowing today or tomorrow.* 

# July 21 2016

I must have missed yesterday. Not much went on. We did watch the kiddies at Wes' house while they went to trivia night. They came in 2<sup>nd</sup> and we had fun with the kids. Today we got ready for the golf visitors, Jim and Jim Jr. They got here around noon. George shot 85, I rallied for an 89 after a just horrible start. Jr. had 93 and Jim had some troubles chipping and was a little over 100. Nice dinner at Carraba's after.

### July 19 2016

Not much doing today. We did the neighborhood walk before it got hot. I did some clearing out of spent flowers on and off thru the day. Mary did a little grocery shopping. I exchanged some texts with Jacob regarding the lawn and zucchini bread.

### July 18 2016

Time marches on. Seems like July is going quickly. We had a good storm this morning and it cleared out just in time to play golf. I was focused this morning for some reason and shot a 2 over 37 on the front nine. Left one on the lip and lipped out another or I could have been somebody. I held it together for 2 more holes before going double double and threw a couple of 3 putts in on the back to shoot 46. Oh well.

Mary did the Y this morning. We have a couple of good days till it warms up for a couple of scorchers.

### July 17 2016

We did the neighborhood walk this morning before things heated up. I pulled some pod tree sprouts for an hr. The kids came over after lunch and we had a good time. We played in the gator garden, ran thru the sprinkler, did PBS kids, watered the flowers, and played with the new toys we bought next door at their garage sale.

The Open was awesome. Stensen whipped Mickelson by shooting 63! Just an awesome round. Phil played very well too but 63 is too much to handle.

#### July 16 2016

Spent the morning and early afternoon watching the Open from Scotland. Quite a golf course, "short" at 7000yards. I think I would shoot somewhere around 110. I was amazed by Mickelson's stats. He has missed 24 greens and is still 11 under par after 54 holes.

Around 10:30 I took Mary to donate platelets. That took 2 hrs and I watched the Open there. Once finished, we went to Tim's for fish and I watched there. We got home and I watched till 2:30 when it was over.

#### July 15 2016

Horrible golf today. Was pulling all my putts. Was cracking the tee ball to no avail. On the 7<sup>th</sup> par 5 I hit a monster drive and 4 hybrid only to land in the par 5 greenside bunker in 2. Ended up with a 7. On the back #14 I almost drove the green but splashed down in the greenside bunker in 1. Ended up with a 5. And so it went for 93 strokes. A full 13 strokes more than yesterday. Pretty sad, eh?

#### July 14 2016

Nice thunderstorm last night passed thru before golf. Cooled things off nicely. I played OK but scored well. Shot 2 over 38 with 1 penalty stroke on the front thanks to some luck and a good short game. Hooked every iron on the front. Not so lucky on the back. Shot 42 with 1 penalty stroke. Straightened out the irons but missed a lot of putts. Just 1 shy of a 79.

Carolyn was over to borrow my car for her SC trip. I get to drive the junker for a week.

### July 13 2016

We did the Y this morning. I did 15 on elliptical and 30min on the treadmill, Mary did yoga. Slow day trying to stay cool. I cut some more spent flowers down but it was steamy.

Did a save files to thumb drive on my laptop. It had been too long at 2+ months. Called about my auqa rug recall and they said they would send one out. Not sure why it was not. Still waiting to finalize condo for Feb. No call yet. Mary paid the bills then went shopping with Brenda. Carolyn stopped in to borrow a suitcase and that's about it here in Lake Wobegone.

# July 12 2016

*Tried to stay cool on a hot day. Did some weeding and cut down some spent flowers. Not much else.* 

Forgot to mention that yesterday I set up the Avista condo for February. Have not closed the deal just yet. Waiting on he owners agent to call. It's about \$200 cheaper than Blue Water Keys. The elevator to the pool is indoor which is nice but the unit is quite a bit smaller.

# July 11 2016

# July 9 2016

Golf at 7:15 tomorrow. Starting early should help with another hot day expected.

### July 6 2016

Busy hot day. We went to the Y this morning. I did 15 on the elliptical and 30min on the treadmill. The lady next to me had major BO. The elliptical machines are 4-5 ft apart and I could OMG smell the BO from there. She left and the air cleared up.

From there it was off to the retiree lunch. Jr. brought Batcher and I helped get him in/out of the car and restaurant. He seemed to enjoy his buddies and just being there. Got home and Jacob was doing the lawn. Mary said he fell asleep when he got there. Must have been whipped from XC practice this morning. He did a top notch job!

I did a few weeds and Mary went to watch the kids for a couple of hrs as Wes and Kaetchen went to trivia night at Maize Valley.

### July 5 2016

### June 30 2016

Wow did I play great with the Lockheed guys at Turkeyfoot. I hit many great shots and had a couple of birdie chances. Started out going over a couple of greens with the hard ground, I dialed it back a bit and played short most holes and had some nice up and downs. Going long was bad since that often gave you a downhill shot. Went 43-42 for an 85 even though I had four or five 3 putts. I didn't let that bother me since their greens are fast and impossible.

Hope to do similar tomorrow at Windmill Lakes. It might be a rainout though.

### June 29 2016

We did the Y. Elliptical for 15min then 30min on the track. We averaged 18min/mile walking 9 and jogging 1. Back home to change and we went for groceries. Did OK on lottery tickets. Won \$33 for \$20 which is not bad. I cleared some grass by the Iris that had grown into them. Took out about 6 inches of grass. Not much else going on. Nice cool day today.

Tomorrow I golf Turkeyfoot while Mary takes Jenna shopping for her birthday gifts.

We replayed the front because the back nine was closed for wetness. Was on track for a nice score till I dumped one in the creek and hit one OB on 16 and 17. Missed a short put on 18 for a 45. I could have been a contender.

My short game improved for 2 reasons: went back to my old lob wedge; used a claw putting grip. I am not sure the claw will hold up where there are slow greens. Dentist and the kids, perhaps a haircut as well tomorrow.

### <u>May 1 2016</u>

April was mostly ugly weather with a few good days thrown in. Lets hope this month will be better. Carolyn met me at HD to pick up the flooring for the guest room. Foggy, misty, and high humidity. I picked up new receptacles for the room. Put in 2 USB on each side of where the bed will go and 2 standard ones in. Took about an hour. I also put a USB one in the Perry Como room.

We bought one of those cooked chickens and feasted on that for dinner. Brenda will likely be home today or tomorrow. Angie, Mitch, and Mads were down there, so they need to be back for work and school.

### April 30 2016

Was out early picking up a few items. We went to the bank around 11am and Jacob came over to get Brenda's lawn done before going over to Pete's and doing his. He got real lucky. The radar said it was raining but it wasn't getting to the ground. It finally rained after he was done.

Between the 2 lawns, he helped me pull out the rug in the guest room downstairs. Carolyn took some of it for the cats and the rest went in the dumpster. Not much of a rain, just enough to mess up your planning.

# April 29 2016

*Mel and I were the only ones that showed up for golf this morning. We both had our issues keeping our heads down. We did much better on the back nine. I went 48-43, mel 52-45. My short game improved but still missed many make-able putts.* 

Got the lawn mowed but it needed it bad. Got my car back from Wes. His is fixed now.

# <u> April 28 2016</u>

Wanted to golf and almost talked myself into it. Glad I did not. It rained on and off till 1:30.

It cleared so we went to the track meet at 5pm. We stayed for the mile. Jacob ran in 5:15, his best yet! Splits were 64,81,89,and 75. Too cold to hang around for the 2 mile. He did well on that one, running in 11:30 and coming in 4th.

# April 27 2016

We did the Y this cold morning around 40. Did 17min on elliptical and then 30 on the treadmill. I tried the bike but the thing cranked up the resistance too high.

We made a short trip for groceries and then I just weeded on and off all day. Supposed to golf tomorrow but weather says low 50s and ½ inch of rain most of the day.

### April 26 2016

We did the Y this am. Started with elliptical and then walked 14 laps and ran 1 (0.1mile/lap). I don't normally run because my left leg starts hurting. If it ever settles down I could run more. That would be a good test.

We moved some iris up by the mailbox. They were getting mixed in with other flowers so we separated them. That was a chore. Later we went to McD and then to the track meet at Hoover. I gave the ticket seller a hard time about not having senior discounts. Green and Glen Oak have them. Next time at Hoover I will go later and they will get nothing from me.

### April 25 2016

*OK. I just had to put a reminder on my computer to do blog updates. Too many missed days lately. Also, the web host was giving me problems I hope were solved yesterday when I called them. The guy said it was a cache problem so he was going to set me up with an vanishing cache. Mumbo jumbo I say. Will know more when I publish today.* 

Busy yesterday. Jacob cut Brenda's and our grass. Then we dropped off the shower chair at Steve's and drove up to Streetsboro to have dinner with George and Willa.

Today I finally broke 90, scoring an 88 at Tannenhauf. I went 44-44. I kept getting

bogies on the back and came down to the last hole needing a par for 89. I whacked one left and rattled around in the trees, so I figured no par was in my future. Turns out it kicked out into the open where I put a 6 iron on the green and made it for a birdie 3. Go figure.

The kids were here when I got back and they kept us busy till about 6:30.

# April 23 2016

Eyes doing OK. They could be better though. Jacob was over to mow for neighbor Pete, but mine just got weed sprayed so it needs to wait a day. Watched the races most of the day. Mary is at church and will cook up the Haddock we bought earlier this week.

# April 22 2016

Eyes much clearer this morning. That is good. We played Mayfair today. I had many pluses. I was hitting the ball farther. 150Yds was a 7 iron instead of a 6 iron. My short game was much better. I made at least 3 putts today. On the minus side, I managed to shoot two 10s on the back nine thanks to look ups in front of ponds. Six penalty strokes on 2 holes.

Steve III is home and doing fine. They have schedules for dr appts and also PT at the hospital. Looks like recovery is progressing nicely.

### April 21 2016

Went in for eye post surgery exam. Doc said everything looked OK. Eyes still irritated so use 2 x drops in left eye and continue on right as prescribed. Picked up some sun glasses at the store and used them at the track meet. Jacob came in 3d against McKinley in the 3200. His time of 11:30 something is a new goal going foreward.

### April 20 2016

Went in for eye surgery at 10:15 and hid inside the rest of the day. They dilate the pupils so the brightness blinds you. Everything seemed to go OK.

### April 19 2016

Lazy day till we went to Jake's track meet. We stayed for the 1600m. He set a new PR with a 5:20 run by quite a bit. The girl at his school ran a 5:19, so he is getting close. I told him he had to beat her by the end of the year. We did not stay for the 2 mile which is 6 events later.

Had a late snack, now I have to fast for my eye surgery tomorrow.

### April 18 2016

*Oh my, missed another day. Was busy yesterday. Jacob cut the grass here and at Brenda's. Wes has car trouble so we dropped my car over to his house and took over all the kids clothes in 7 storage boxes, sorted for girls/boys/age.* 

Today I golfed badly again. Good drives, poor irons, horrible short game. Never did make a putt. Weather was nice though.

# April 16 2016

Not much doing today. Mostly worked on the grass intruding into the mulch bed. It was very low priority last fall as I was recovering from my bypass. It kind of got out of hand. Of the 6 beds, I have cleared three. I have done the largest one, the bed around the house which is huge. Have another one half done and will be using grass/weed killer around the other two. More to do.

Mary finished the kids clothes wash and store.

# April 15 2016

Finally played golf again, but not so well. Went 45-46 at Brookledge. I rarely play well on their fast greens and this was no different. I did get one birdie out of 2 tries but missed many many putts. Oh well. I will do better the next round on Monday. Our Monday ranks are down to 5 right now. Hoole is in chemo, Darrell's wife is ill, and Bob M has prostrate cancer.

The kids were over and wore us out. Katchen is having a boy. On a sad note, Rd. Phil's wife Sherry has passed away. She recently had some type of transplant and it didn't work out. That is all the details we have right now.

### April 14 2016

Did the Y this morning. 15 min on eliptical and 30 min on the track. Mary went with me. We headed over to see Steve III at 10am or so. We had to wait a bit for the nurses to clear out. The PT was about to get him up to walk but she said she would come back later.

We had a nice conversation with him. He seemed happy but said he felt guilty about all the trouble he has been. Also said he "owed us a lot". We never did figure that one out. I guess we will learn more when he improves and gets his head back on straight.

Stopped for a Stricklands on the way home. Did a little weeding. Tomorrow golf and then the kids while mom and dad go to the doctor.

### April 13 2016

Did the Y this morning then went to eye dr for 1 week check. He was happy with the healing after surgery. Back home to mow the lawn. It was still low 50s so it was cold. I did inspire a couple of neighbors to mow as well. Lawn looks nice.

Stopped at the bank to renew the home equity loan. Unlikely I will use it but it is nice to have in your back pocket.

# April 12 2016

I did an online seminar from Fidelity from 9-11:30 where they showed growth, value, and dividend based investing screens. They did some sample screens so it was very helpful. Not much else going on. Will have a busy day tomorrow including eye dr appt, bank appt. and maybe mowing.

### April 11 2016

Jeez. The snow melted under last night's rain but then it rained all day long. Standing water everywhere. What a crappy month. I don't think there has been one single nice day so far. Reminds me of rain in Myrtle Beach. Rain rain rain. Second straight rainout of Monday golf. Duckworth wanted me to sub tomorrow. I told him maybe when the weather is better.

Went to the Y this am. We went to see Hello, my name is Doris with Sally Field and then out to Texas Roadhouse. The food was especially good.

Steve III is doing good. They stopped dialysis to see if his kidneys will take over and get the job done. We all hope so.

### April 10 2016

Snow did not melt and we had more flurries. I did a Ted's party. Don cooked the dogs out in the cold. We had Loganberry, fries, and rings. The rings didn't turn out. Too soggy for some reason. I got a nice shirt, ball finding glasses, and Texas Roadhouse gift card. Carolyn also helped with the fuel perks, a savings of \$45.

More good news. Steve III moved to step down unit.

### April 9 2016

Sigh, another 4" of snow. Kind of ridiculous, eh? Mary did a hair appt and church. I just kinda of watched the horse races. Absurd weather.

Great news from Steve. They pulled the tubes and Steve III is eating slowly.

### April 8 2016

Carolyn stopped over with the gas cans and gave me a nice card. Let the Grim Reaper play through it said.

My eye is healing good. Very sharp and bright at distance, fuzzy up close.

We went to get stuff for my party Sunday. Now I can settle down and watch the

# Masters.

# April 7 2016

*My birthday today. I am 1000100 today. Went to the eye surgery follow up appointment. They said everything looks OK so far. The eye is good at distance and is much brighter now but everything close is blurry. I hope that improves. Not much else was going on so we opened a puzzle.* 

Doc said OK to golf. That is a plus. Wish we had some golf weather now.

# <u> April 6 2016</u>

Surgery went well. I don't remember anything till they wheeled me back to the prep area. Things were very bright the rest of the day with the dilation drops. I headed to bed early at 9pm and slept pretty good.

# April 5 2016

A lot of waiting around today. Finally found out as surgery is at 12:15 tomorrow.

We went to Jacob's track meet. He ran an 800 relay leg and an 11:30 two mile. He seemed happy with his times.

We got to the hospital at 8:45 to visit Steve III. He was all tubed up and looked in constant pain. All he could do is nod his head. Quite pathetic. The nurse said dialysis can be rough on you especially at the start. We only stayed ½ hour in the ICU.

### April 4 2016

I did the Y this morning while Mary went to a doctor appt. There was 2" of snow on the ground so there was no reason to head to the golf course. Another boring day.

### April 3 2016

Missed another day. We were busy yesterday. Went to Jacob's track meet. He ran in a mile relay and went 1:14 for the first 400 then 1:28 the others for a 5:28 mile. Later he ran a 2:28 800m. Still some work to do but a decent start on a cold cold day. It snowed later around dark. Did some grocery shopping later on.

Woke this morning to 2 " of snow. It gradually melted off as the temp got to the low 40s. I found a paint over the sink note in the job jar, so I did that and washed off the blinds. They were very dusty. Glad I got something done this weekend.

Nothing from Steve so I called hospital. Jr is all tubed up now. They said he has rhabdo 2 hr dialysis trial yesterday reduced cpk from 500,000 to 30,000, so they will put him on for 3 hrs tomorrow. Steve thinks things have turned the corner now but he could be in there for a long time. He is thinking Jr stopped his anti seizure meds as there were delays in

getting him on medicaid when he returned to this country from South Africa. He cant talk with all the tubes down his throat so its hard to communicate.

### April 1 2016

*Did 3d session at the Y for the week. My left leg struggles a bit due to the missing veins. It's April Fools Day. Might be something to that as I have plummeted from 1300 chess rating to 1215.* 

Nothing new on Steve III.

We went over for Kalix' bday. She had a good time. That is quite a swing set Grandpa Craig put together for her. Mary is going over later to watch the kids while they do a mystery thing tonight.

### March 31 2016

Rainy and very windy day the last day in March. We survived March in Ohio. I give the March weather a D minus.

Boring day today so we did the Y this morning. 15 min on the elliptical and 30 minutes walking on the track. How about more boring? I shredded a box of tax forms and stuff for 2+ hours. You don't need more than 7 years so I got rid of the old ones. Put away some Easter stuff too.

Sorry to hear last night that Joan Herbold passed away. She was the grandmother that raised Jim Jr. She did a good job at that and helped mother with yard work for many years while she was able. Jr posted a nice tribute to her on his FB page.

Another concern is Steve III is in the ICU, perhaps in Ravenna. I can't find anything out cause Steve isn't answering his phone. He looked fine here Easter?

### March 30 2016

I needed to give the drain bolt another couple of quarter turns on my bathroom repair last night to stop the water leaks. Glad that is over.

Cold start but warmed up to 60s. I shot 44-46 and Dick 47-49 today. I had a poor start on both nines and finished OK Didn't have the green speed down and that hampered my scoring.

I picked up a metric bolt at HH for the swing repair. I had thought it was beyond repair since I could not find a replacement part. When the kids were over, Wes simply used duck tape to tie the canopy on where the plastic had broken. I decided I needed to think outside the box. I researched and figured a pipe clamp would grab the canopy bar and all I had to do was screw the pipe clamp into the swing bolt hole. It worked like a charm! I just need to remember to think outside the box next time I run into a repair problem. Did a bit of weeding after golf to get rid of grass encroaching on the driveway island.

### March 29 2016

Cold morning. Warmed up a bit but still mid 40s. We did the Y this morning. It has been about a week since last visit.

So I started to do some plumbing early. Good thing. I got a new drain fixture for the down bathroom. Nothing at HH so I went to Lowes to find it since it was brass colored. Started the install and the drain fixture was too long. A trip to HH and the guy said I need to saw it off shorter. That I did. It leaked of course, so I tightened things up. I will have to go down later and check to see if another round of tightening is in the cards.

Put oil and gas in the mower and charger the battery for awile. Jacob hopefully will cut tomorrow.

# March 28 2016

Yesterday the ladies went to Easter mass. They got home and peeled potatoes, chopped cabbage, and did the cooking. It was one of our most people ever parties of 13. Carolyn's family plus don's mother, john/Ginny, Steve/Steve III, Wes, Catherine, and us. The food was great and the weather fantastic allowing us to spend a lot of time outdoors. I wish I could have Katchen's family and the kids but 13 was enough and 6 more would have been impossible without eating in shifts.

As for today, another crappy day in the low 40s and windy. Catherine was off 9:30ish and left us a horde of chocolate. I had told her to take it, the bum. John and Ginny left 11ish. Before they left, John helped me pull off the florescent light cover and replace my bulbs with LED ones. They look quite nice and always turn right on. No ballast issues like in the past with the florescents.

### March 26 2016

Kind of a crappy day yesterday, but the sun did come out at 6pm. The fish fry was very good.

A cool 32 this morning, it warmed up to mid 50s so not so bad. The ladies sewed this morning and got Jenna's dress ready. Jenna had swimming this morning so Carolyn picked up the dress for her and she was going to finish it and wear it for Easter. Catherine came around 1:30. John and I vegetated all day and will probably do the same tomorrow. Should be a full house with 12 for dinner tomorrow.

### March 25 2016

Cold today, right about 40. Jenna came over to sew and I picked up Jacob after practice while Carolyn was working. Kaetchen brought the kids over to get the wagon John and Ginny brought for them from Texas. It is pretty awesome, a real gem. The kids had fun with it. Later on it's a fish fry at the Serbian church. The other churches don't do Good Friday so there is not much choice.

### March 24 2016

Much warmer today. I played a good round shooting 42-39 = 81. I was smacking drives right on the sweet spot and hitting all clubs solid. I made 2 birdie putts in 3 opportunities, so I was happy with that as well. I focused on smoothing the club down and staying still over the ball.

Dick came around to shoot 48-45 and was much improved. Denny sent out the first 3 tee times. The bad news is Houle said he starts chemo tomorrow for 20 weeks for a fist sized tumor on his bladder. They will remove it after chemo is over. Yikes.

### March 23 2016

Was warmer than expected this morning at 55. Dick played for the first time since getting his pacemaker. He can feel it on his turn somewhat restricting his backswing. He struggled but played better when he relaxed. I went 48-43. Too many bad chips on the front, better on the back. Very windy on the back nine.

Mary went to the Y and bowling. John and Ginny are due in tomorrow. I may play once again if the rain holds off till noon.

#### March 22 2016

Last night we ran out to get Kalix bday gifts cause we thought the party was this Wednesday. Tuns out it is next week.

Had Dr appt this morning. Eye Dr wanted clearance for the cataract surgery. My doc said anyone alive and still breathing is OK with him, lol. Got a haircut after.

The kids were over from 12-3pm. We did an Easter egg hunt and colored some eggs, then played this and that. Golf tomorrow, I hope.

#### March 21 2016

OMG I missed another day. Yesterday Mary did church. Carolyn and Jacob came over later. I ordered Jacob a late bday gift for his airsoft gun. We were in SC for his bday so we missed it. I did some ceiling paint touch up to complete the bathroom light bar move. Guess I was brain dead in the evening and did not get to my blog.

Today we did the Y then went to pick up storage bins for Wes at HD, then did our Easter grocery shopping. I got all the Easter baskets filled and the eggs for hiding for the kids.

March 19 2016

Now it's high 30s. We planned to go to the Cleveland Remodeling show, which I had thought was at the IX Center. We got up there and I asked which door the home show was at. Guy said there was just 1 show here and the one I wanted was downtown Cleveland at the convention center. Yet another senior moment.

I did not bring the gps, so I opted to go to the Cleveland Zoo. We had a good time there and stopped at the Lizard on the way home.

### March 18 2016

It was a nice day today. That is really aggravating since the forecast was for a high of 38 and I did not schedule golf today. There was a frost this morning but the sun came out and it was a 55 degree day. Damn those weathermen!

We did the Y this morning, stopped at McD for breakfast, and picked up the chocolate bunnies this morning. We just got back from the fish fry. Mary had to take a pie in for the dessert table.

Also did a little ceiling patch where we moved the light fixture the other day.

# March 17 2016

Last "warm" day for awhile so I jumped out early at sable creek and got a 2hr 20min 18 in. Went 45-40 with 2 pars on the front and 5 pars on the back thanks to two long putts dropping in. I was very happy. Only 3 bad swings for the round.

Got back and cut the grass and finished up at lunchtime. The kids came over at 3:30 till 6:30 and had a good time. They ate lots of goodies too. Tomorrow I need to pick up the bunnies for Easter and chow down on the fish fry.

### March 16 2016

Wow this every other day thing is catching on for some reason. Yesterday I helped Carolyn do her brakes. There was loud squeaking going on she said. Well, we changed them and they had a lot more life left to them. The noise stopped for some reason?? We were talking about what she wanted to do with her bathroom lighting and she was thinking of a light bar like we have. That reminded me that mine needed to be centered, so that we did. Need to fix the ceiling area now exposed after the move.

Today I went to lunch with Rudy and we bumped into Lockheed guys Zowalski, Babyak, and Castro. Babyak was in town from Owego for his wife's shoulder surgery, and Castro was in from Orlando for some reason. Nice to catch up with 4 guys that worked for me in the past. Carolyn called and I went over to put her light bar up. Good thing Holmes wasn't around to see it. There was no box there, just a wire, so we punched in the wall a bit to make a spot to stuff the wires back in. To do it right, we should put a box in.

#### March 14 2016

Oops missed a day once again. It was a rainy day with nothing to do. I checked and didn't find any good movies to see. There was a Stark H&G show, but we decided to go this coming Saturday to the one in Cleveland at the IX center. So we just pulled out the mystery puzzle and did that all day. My diet was over so I wolfed down ½bag of jelly beans.

Today we did the Y and more of the puzzle. We have finished the one with all the clues in it and are having trouble with the sky of the other scene of the crime puzzle. I figured out who did it and got it right. Mary has yet to set aside some time for solving it.

Went to see Ken Batcher under Hospice care at his home. He enjoyed our visit even though his wife was the non stop talker. He said he feels no worse than last time. The lung cancer has not worsened he says.

We stopped At Parrasons for dinner. It wasn't cheap. Lasagna was 9.50 as was the chicken sub I had. We got out just in time to get to the car before the storm dumped a lot of rain. I pulled over for 5 minutes in a CVS parking lot before heading back. The storm was nasty.

### March 12 2016

Granddaughter Jenna stayed overnight and was very good. Mary took her home after breakfast while I went to Quail Hollow to watch Wes run the 5K. The kids were there as well. I mostly watched Zander play in the sand.

Wes was smoked by 2 high school Lake runners but came in 3d. He was quite a ways back and the next runner quite a ways back from him. He just trained on the treadmill at the Y and that really did not get him into shape he said.

They came over after for lunch and play. We did a lot outside since it was so nice out. After they left Mary did church and I played some excellent chess. I had slipped down slightly to 1240 the last few days, but I was whacking players left and right and topped out at 1300. I'll be headed back down shortly.

### March 11 2016

*Oops, looks like I missed yesterday's blog. Yesterday we went to Walmart to get the Easter candy. I think we loaded up with \$80 worth before picking up some groceries.* 

Today I played golf. My 3 buddies bailed on me citing wet and cold. Talk about Bernie Kosar. I played decent on the par 36 front with 2 doubles and the rest bogies. Distance was a problem as the drives carried 170-180 and stopped quick on the wet stuff. The back was very ugly. Something went wrong and I don't think I hit more than one good shot or two. Bad swings, topped balls, look ups. One ball was very tired of my poor play that it hid on me after my sky'd tee shot on #16. I didn't see any real wet areas where I hit it but I sure couldn't find it. All in all it was a 50 on a par 34 back. Two triples, three doubles, and four bogies. Pretty pitiful.

Need more work with my new wedge. And oh yeah, a golf swing. Most of the course was OK with just a few puddles here and there.

The fish fry at the church was excellent once again. Too bad I am on a diet till Sunday cause the deserts looked very good.

# March 9 2016

Did this weeks second Y session. Twas tough after the stick workout we got yesterday. Not much else going on so I did remove some grass from the mulch bed edges. That kept the pain coming.

Now we have 3 for Friday golf. Latest temps I have seen indicates it will be cold in the low 40s till afternoon. Might be a dropout or two.

# March 8 2016

Last week I was bored a couple of days so I decided to go over to Carolyn's today and pick up sticks. First we cut down her tall grass. That made an excellent starter for a fire. That stuff really went up and I got a good fire started. I mostly tended the fire with Mary and Carolyn getting the lawn cleared of the big sticks.

We quit after 3 hours and it was a good decision. I was moaning and a groaning the rest of the day. The back of my legs were hurting from bending over.

### March 7 2016

Did the machines at the Y. Getting to like the ellipical now. I set it on level 1 and do 10 minutes. It gets my heart rate up quickly to 110 or so. Getting to 110 on the treadmill or bike takes a lot of effort and leg pain so I usually set the bike at 100 and the treadmill at 105. I may see if I can do more time on the elliptical.

This is day to of the low carb diet. I can feel the pounds sliding off already. Did a lot of weeding as the temps reached 60+. Might be sore tomorrow. Plan to pick up some sticks at Carolyn's tomorrow. Something to keep busy, eh?

### March 6 2016

We went grocery shopping and picked up pork loin roasts for Easter dinner in a couple of weeks. I watched the Doral PGA tournament and saw one guy miss a put be looking up and pushing a putt. Also saw the winner shank one out of the bunker. I guess they can mess up the same way I do on occasion.

### March 5 2016

More snow today but it melted pretty quick. Dug up and scanned some documents for

sister Sue. Wes dropped the kids off at 1:30 and we watched them till 6:30. We kept busy and they wore us out.

### March 4 2016

Woke up to 2.5 inches of snow on the grass, not so much on the driveway. I went off to do the machines at the Y, and Mary to Yoga. Things were slow for awhile, then I helped Carolyn with her door handle problem. We came up with a working fix that just might have to be re-fixed from time to time.

Met Wes and the kids at the fish fry. The kids should be over tomorrow. Better get a good nights sleep, eh?

### March 3 2016

Boring day. Mary took her car in for service. I played some online chess and watched the stock pundits. Mitt Romney and Trump were entertaining. Mitt said Trump was a fraud and Trumpe called Mitt a choking loser. I did some vacuuming and hung my Pez poster in the toy room.

Can't wait for next weeks warm up.

#### March 2 2016

Did the exercise machines at the Y today. Looking out I saw snow instead of the ocean and 28 degrees to boot. Headed over to the retiree lunch about 10am and saw lots of old buddies.

Next up was a trip to the eye doctor where they measured my eyes for the new IOL lenses they were going to insert. It is quite the process with eye drops 3 days before and 4 weeks after. It all starts in April.

Sister Catherine messed me up sending Good and Plenty candy. I guess my diet will need to wait a week till I finish it up.

#### March 1 2016

Back in Ohio after 11+ hours of travel yesterday. Going to be cold this week here but it warms up next week. Could golf be far behind?

What a busy day. Took most of the day to recover. Grocery shopping, then pick up the mail, then read the mail. Reading the mail was unpleasant. Two Akron General bills for hospital stays of \$1080 if I paid by the 5<sup>th</sup>. Paid it quickly and saved \$700.

Mary was busy doing many loads of wash today. I think we are pretty much back to normal now. We should be busy again tomorrow with Bowling, retiree lunch, and eye doctor appointment.

5 more mornings till we leave for MB.

Did the Y this morning. Treadmill was 15 min on cardio 110 setting. Tried the bike but it

was very difficult to push up to even 105. By the time I got there my legs were too tired to carry on. Did just 5 minutes. I am puzzled as to why the bikes are so difficult lately?

Was beckoned over to Carolyn's to help her put down backer board for her bathroom tile. We got it cut and down and then used the dremmel to ready the doorway to slide the tile under. Afterwards, I got my car washed so it doesn't have to sit a month in the garage with salt all over it.

### Jan 24 2016

6 more mornings till we leave for MB.

9 more mornings till we leave for MB.

This morning I had two Jan 21s in the blog but found my error back on the 18<sup>th</sup> and fixed it all up. Wes was over last night and set up Mary's new flip phone. Her old one had the sound fading in and out so she needed a new one. Got the cheapest they had at \$49. Carolyn was getting the verizon emails, so I fixed that.

I was bugging Carolyn about getting her bathroom floor fixed before I leave. Turns out she had it done by Mike already. Maybe she will have some work for me when I get back. Today we did some grocery shopping and picked up some stuff for MB as well. Hopefully we have the food planned so it all runs out in 9 days and we won't have to toss much.

Neighbor Brenda is going to go down to Florida for a couple of months. She is going to put in a new back door to the garage. I told her I could help Mike if he gets to it by the end of the month.

Should be quiet the rest of the day and for most of next week come to think about it.

### <u>Jan 20 2016</u>

10 more mornings till we leave for MB.

Went to the Y around 8;30am. Did the treadmill, this time for 25min with 105 heart rate target. Did great. Going to try 110 next time. We saw Wes there. He said the kids are going over to Carolyn's while they do the doctor visit. They are pumped.

I re-sealed the bathroom vanity along the back. I had some sealer but I could not pump it out of the tube, so I had to make a run to HH to pick up some new stuff. I hope it drys asap so we can get back to using it.

<u>Jan 19 2016</u>

11 more mornings till we leave for MB.

Got back on the horse today. Went to the Y around 8;30am. Did the treadmill 15min OK but my left leg was a bit tired. Then cycled but cut it short to 10min as that leg was again struggling. I was happy with the workout though, just need to strengthen the legs. Mary went as well.

Had lunch with Rudy at Johnny Js. Went with a cod fish stick appetizer which was good. Rudy was out of work since Xmas. To keep busy he has been reworking his basement. That's where the kids hung out, so he had a ton of nicks in the drywall to fix. He said his wife is OK with him not working but if she sees him sitting around not doing anything, he gets yelled at. He better line up some more projects, eh?

Later on I reloaded the bird feeder. Not a lot of birds around but a few have been taking seed there.

### Jan 18 2016

Well, my luck runs supreme. First off, I rooted for KC to beat NE. Nothing doing. Then I cheered for Seattle. Nope. Finally I told Mary and sister Sue that the Steelers need not even play cause I was going to root for them. Done deal. They lost too. Sorry Steeler fans.

They are always on TV around Easter and Halloween to get free advertising on the local news shows. Been wanting to go there for years. We got a bunch of candy and took pictures of it. There were many shoppers there and a good percentage of them brought their kids along for the fun. We stopped at the Winking Lizard on the way back for lunch. Mary had a salad and I had the Buffalo Chicken sandwich.

We heard that they are going to do exploratory surgery on Dennis looking for where he is bleeding. They do believe it is between the stomach and the large intestine.

### Jan 15 2016

The market tanked once again today. It is down 8% already this year. Please stop! Not much doing today. I got a haircut this morning then took it easy before visiting the doctor at 2:30pm.

No real issues. He just wanted to keep up to date since my surgery. I was so glad to update him and gave him \$20 to boot. Now how can you beat that? We stopped on the way home at Handels and had our dessert first.

Neighbor Pete took down his outdoor decorations. I was surprised he didn't have Jacob help.

### Jan 14 2016

The missing gall bladder maybe was useful in the past. I now seem to feel a little uncomfortable if I eat too much. I will have to eat smaller meals I guess. Also seems that digestion takes longer.

Not much doing today. Went out and got the paper pushing the shovel to the box. We got maybe another 2 inches which I did not expect. No biggie. The driveway melted off by mid afternoon. I got a cramp in my right side back. Mary got me the hot water bottle and that did the trick.

Golf buddy Dick Lott passed out at home and he went to the hospital. He has lived with missed heartbeats for many many years but this seems to be causing issues now. They are planning to put in a pacemaker.

### Jan 13 2016

Carolyn brought over Jenna's laptop and I was able to set up the logitech universal remote. That was a relief cause I already had 2 hrs talking to their support people under my belt. It does not work as I had thought but it can be used to control all the devices.

I met up with Jane at Ken Batcher's house. He is signed up with Hospice care. The bazaar thing is I don't think he knows he is. He certainly does not talk like someone who knows they are on their way out. Wife Silvia can talk. OMG, I don't think I have ever heard someone that can non-stop talk like she can. It was good to see him. He still wants to get transported to the retiree lunch but I don't see that happening.

Jan 12 2016

Not much going on today. Bored again. It was a nasty snow day with 3-4 down and slippery morning roads. I am going to go out a bit and see if I need to blow snow. I tried chess again and reversed yesterdays form. Went from 1120 back up to 1185! The brain is a funny thing. Didn't work yesterday but works today.

Stocks were crazy today. Market was up and then tanked. I had one that was up 400 now down 200. Should have sold! I did reserve a motel in Winston Salem for our ride down. 7 hrs to there then another 3-4 in the morning. Doing the full drive is a bit hectic. You have to try to get there by 4pm to pick up keys and it is always close.

Kids were over and wore us out.

### Jan 11 2016

Not much going on today. I was totally bored. Cut up some cardboard for recycle and put away tools and stuff in the laundry room. I tried to play chess but was getting whacked right and left. Fell from 1175 down to under 1120 ratings. Tomorrow looks to be more of the same. I do want to get to Cleveland to b.a. sweetie candy store sometime.

Oh yeah, spent another hr on the phone with Logitech trying to get my new universal remote working. There software is crap and the service techs too. After an hour the final verdict is I need to use a different computer.

### <u>Jan 10 2016</u>

Jacob came over late around noon. The snow hit about then so we had to work in the cold. The 2 mailbox assembly went together great. I had him do all the drilling and screwing, Then we went out into the cold and knocked off the old boxes. I had 2 angle brackets with 12 screws to mount it. What a joke. It took us 3 tries. I guess I need to go to screw school. I snapped off 3 screws and stripped the heads of about 8 until we got enough in to hold the assembly onto the post.

Jacob had got out the storage boxes earlier and Mary packed up the tree ornaments. Jacob took all the boxes down, stored them under the stairs, then moved all the furniture around. He was a Godsend. All the work was wrapped up by 3;30pm.

### Jan 9 2016

Quiet day today. We started to pile up Christmas stuff to put away tomorrow. I put the train away as well.

Jacob is coming over tomorrow. He can get out the storage boxes and Mary can get the tree ornaments packed up. Meanwhile, Jacob and I can put the new mailbox wood together. If all goes well and it is not to rainy, maybe we can get it onto the post outside. The old mailboxes got beat up in the tornado. I guess we should have got to this last fall. When the Christmas stuff is packed, we can get it all stored away till next year. Bro-in-law and golfer Dennis has been in the hospital and got 3 units of blood. They were supposed to do an upper GI probe today to see what is going on. On another note Ken Batcher Sr. is now under hospice care. I was surprised about this. He still may recover and it is a bit early to say he won't make it, but I guess the family knows best. Ken is in his early 80s I believe.

Jan 1 to Jan 8 2016

Happy New Year.

Holy crap what a lousy start to the year. We went into the emergency room new year eve because I had some pain in my side and a bit of an upset stomach, puking twice. They sent me to the hospital saying the Cat scan indicated gall bladder. The hospital did ultra sound looking for stones. Didn't find any but the gall bladder looked very odd. They took the sucker out the next day.

Normally an easy surgery, my body did not like it. I got swelled up and wasn't going home till I got my bodily functions back working. That took till Wednesday night, and it came on like gangbusters. Spent a lot of time in the bathroom. After I did ok with food Thursday morning they cut me loose. It was pretty funny. After nothing but clear liquids since new year eve, I was dreaming of toast. All the while, Mary was supporting me. I got thru it with her help and am very grateful. You wouldn't believe how depressing it is to not to be able to pee or poop at age 67. I guess I will most likely get to experience this again down the road.

I still need to get rid of a bunch of water and get the swelling in my lower legs down, although this doesn't hold me back much.
