July 6 2025

I did put in the grab handles in the front and garage doorways. Vicki has trouble getting in so that will help her. Don't think we will need them for the near future, but they are there now.

Pretty much vegged all day. Carolyn took Jacob for his drivers test. He passed and will have a drivers license now.

Watered the flowers in the evening. No luck at Belmont today.

July 4 2025

We did a little on the puzzle early morning and decided to get dressed. Good thing. Vicki rang the doorbell. I quickly put something on and invited her in. She stayed almost an hour.

When she left, we went to Walmart to get me another arch support for my indoor shoes because they worked out so good in my golf shoes. Picked up a few other items as well.

Worked a bit more on the puzzle then went over to get some pre-cooked ribs at Acme around 3pm. They were out of the on sale ribs so we took the smoked ones. Wow they are good. We only ate a half rack and have the rest for tomorrow.

We were going to take Jacob to the Rock Hall tomorrow but he wants to do other things tomorrow. Gonna do a drivers test to get his license back so he has that for interviews. He is doing good sort of. However, he has his mind set about staying with Allie near Cleveland and get a full time job there.. Carolyn and I don't think this is a good idea and want to see a degree first and only a part time job somewhere close to Kent to minimize driving.

<u>July 3 2025</u>

Oops, forgot to post yesterday. We went to the Y. I messed up and we were 30 min early so we did a treadmill for 20 min. Went for my full body scan at 4pm and got out with a clean bill of health.

Today I played Arrowhead with Chuck, and Sammy. Shot an 87 and it could have been much lower. Two penalties and 4 putts left right in front of the hole. My feet felt great with the new arch supports. Left heel was a bit sore at the end but in general my feet felt good. Hope to find a couple more supports for my shoes and slippers tomorrow.

Lobys for dinner was fun. We talked to our buddies there. Wish I could remember their names. The flatbread was a little on the crisp side though.

July 1 2025

Feet hurt this morning so we skipped the Y. Hope to go tomorrow.

Mary did a bunch of wash we dragged home from the weekend plus what was here already.

We did go to Acme for a few items we needed. Later we went to BJs for some items Jacob wanted. Did a lot of texting with him this afternoon. Couldn't get mom to give him a car, so he was trying to work on me. Got to give him credit for being persistent. His latest idea is to grab a job in Cleveland and get his degree remote from Kent. Doubt if that is even possible.

June 29 2025

We decided to go to Mass at 10am at Our Lady of Victory Basilica in south buffalo since it was so beautiful. What a stunning church. I must have taken 30 pictures there. Behind it is where Mary's brother Jim body resides in a Mausoleum. We visited there and stopped at Tim Hortons for a sandwich.

After that we went to Ruths and helped set up for Brad's graduation party. Ste up tables and chairs and decorations. It was a good party. We dragged ourselves away at 630 and did the hotel pool. Catherine joined us. We were in the pool for around 75 minutes.

June 28 2025

We packed up some clothes for our Buffalo trip. We will pack the personal items and electronics tomorrow.

<u>June 25 2025</u>

Did not sleep very well. Thinking back to Neil and all the good times we had in prep for visiting him.

We went to the Y class this morning. I took it easy and skipped some of the side to side movement as it put pressure on my heals. The other ones I could keep on my toes and avoid stressing my heel.

After class, I headed up to see Neil at Arbors in Stow. Dick was also going but he ended up at the Arbors Strongsville. His memory is indeed slipping. He had been here at least 2 other times with me.

Neil looked as good as ever. Mostly non-responsive, he did wake up a few times and acknowledge our presence. We both enjoyed our visits. I was there for about 90 minutes, Dick maybe 40 min.

Mary stayed at the Y for the next class and bummed around with Brenda all day. I got home at 2pm. It's 3 now and she looks to be at Cracker Barrel now.

June 24 2025

Happy anniversary Wes! Number 18 I believe. He is on the island with the family. Hope they have A/C.

I had trouble getting to sleep so we skipped the early Y class this morning. The guys from Americraft were here this morning and spent till 2pm fixing a crack in the foundation in the other half of this condo building. They did an excellent job! I think they got paid well too. 3 guys for 5 hrs and a small digger for \$5000. They did use a couple of feet of PVC, some rubber sealing stuff, and some gravel though.

We did a little yard work and took a walk later in the evening to keep busy. Mary did several loads of wash.

Tomorrow I will visit Neil and Sandy at the nursing home after the Y. He is mostly non responsive but Sandy will like having us there.

June 23 2025

Quiet morning. I went to the foot doctor and got advice on my feet. She gave me 2 stretches to do. Recommended ice and ibuprofen for pain. Got me arch supports for the golf shoes.

She said rest is good but no more than a week or two. We talked about the night foot brace. She said to wear it a couple hrs during the day since it disturbed my sleep. As for the Y, I must avoid any high impact exercises like the jacks. Arch supports are good to take pressure off the fascia.

We went dress shopping a little later. No luck at Cato's or Target but we did find some nice ones at Kohls.

Finally, we emptied the piggy bank. Took all the coins to Giant Eagle and ended up with \$140 in gift cards at Texas Roadhouse and Outback.

<u>June 22 2025</u>

We went to church today. Father Bob's last weekend. He is moving to lead 6 churches to our east. We stopped at Acme and picked up a few items.

Jacob and Allie stopped by. Guess Jacob wanted to show her were he stayed for a year or so. He swapped scooters so he could get the faster one I had fixed. They visited

Carolyn as well.

We had leftovers today. I ate 2 more hamburger Station sliders and tossed the last one. Ate 6 in all since Wes brought them over. Carolyn stopped in as well and later on we went to ROs for the hot fudge sundae.

Tomorrow I go to the foot doctor to see what she says is a good action plan for my planter fasciites.

June 21 2025 (posted June 22)

Took it easy toy and stayed in most of the day. We did go out to Poagies in Louisville for BBQ around 2 pm. Awesome food in a small place. Nice outdoor tables with umbrellas kept us cool on a 90 degree day. Glad the humidity was low.

Spent a couple of hours on the scooters. Pulled the one we just got back from Jacob apart and finally fixed the broken wire. This is the 3d time for that wire. First time it had just pulled out of the connector; second time I fixed it with a half assed solder joint; this time I made a robust solder joint that should lase a long time.

Took the dead scooter apart. Didn't think it was worth fixing since we still have 3 working ones. Had no clue what was wrong since it doesn't power up and provide an error code. Saved a bunch of little pieces parts for future use. Tossed the base in the trash and the battery part aside for hazardous waste later on.

By the time I went to bed, my feet felt pretty good? Not sure I did anything good other than rest them and take a few ibuprofen?

Carolyn and Jenna stopped over around dinnertime.

<u>June 20 2025</u>

Well found out the feet still need lots of attention and rest at golf today. Ended up walking 3.4 miles. Moving really slow now. Didn't help my golf. Smacked some drives but that was it. Irons really sucked. Don't think I ever did hit a crisp one the whole round. Did get 1 birdie by making my 1 putt for the day. Big plus was I took \$2 back from JT.

We had leftover Hamburger Station. Still good. The pickles and onion rule!

Carolyn went up to Kent and got Jacob set up for a drivers test to get his license back but they ran out of time. He will have to be tested next week.

<u>June 19 2025</u>

Decided to pass on the Y today and keep resting the feet. They are feeling much better today. Wonder how much of a setback golf will be tomorrow.

Mary got her hair done today. Afterwards, we went to Loby's and had the flatbread pizza. Scored a \$500 pull tab after quite a drought the last several weeks. Maybe luck is returning?

I dread playing Brookledge tomorrow. Their greens and I do not agree. Better chip them close tomorrow.

<u>June 18 2025</u>

Decided to pass on the Y today and keep resting the feet. Mary decided to do some wash today.

I looked at the scooter I brought back from Jacobs. Tightened all the loose screws and used locktite. Charged ok. When I gave it a test drive, it failed with error 54 again. Crap! Looks like the solder joint fix was substandard and failed. Have to do better this time. What a pain. Hopefully I can fix it in under 2 hours and wont strip any of the cheap screws.

Wes brought over Hamburger Station family pack for my fathers day dinner! Yum! I had 2 sliders and 2 onion rings and some fries. Got a grill tool set with golf grips. Pretty cool.

Carolyn went up to Kent and got Jacob some non-drivers insurance. Something he needs to retake his drivers license test. Sounds like something that is a kickback perk for politicians? Can't get your license back unless you have non-drivers insurance first??

June 17 2025

Forgot to post last night. My feet were just killing me from my golf round. Shot 85 at Tannenhauf. The 3 putts got to me; all 3 of them.

My feet felt a little better this morning. I was going to rest them today but that wasn't gonna happen. We walked down to see the tree work. They did a great job and the owners were happy. Stump was not ground out as of yet. Maybe we want to keep it to prevent erosion?

We went to pick up prescriptions and I found some inserts for my golf shoes.

Jacob finally responded to my texts and we decided to go to Kent. We got his laundry done, picked up a small cooling fan for him, delivered the scooter, laundry pods, water, and cat food and fixed his lamp.

He was really down the last couple of days. He believes Carlos was stealing from him and he had an argument with Allie too. There went the idea of rooming with Carlos. On top of all that, he has spent whatever he had left and still no job.

That means he will default on all his card payments and his credit will be shot in a couple of weeks. Bad behavior has caught up with him. He is thinking he will stay with Allie but it is unlikely that that will work out. Good thing he has a couple months rent Carolyn is holding or he would be out on the streets soon.

June 15 2025

We went to church this morning and stopped at Acme to pick up a few items. Had sandwich and chips for lunch.

Tried the add on battery I took off the dead scooter on the backup I had at Carolyn's and it was still alive and well. I attached it to the scooter and used the blue locktite. Seems like the scooter vibration always loosens the screws and causes issues. Maybe the locktite will prevent more of the same.

Vicki stopped over for a half hour. We were going to take the scooter and some other items to Kent but Jacob preferred Tuesday instead so we headed to ROs for a hot fudge sundae for dinner.

Amazon delivered my new indoor ortho slip ons I need to wear to ease the wear on my planter fasciites. Also my massage gun to use on my calves ans feet for the same.

June 14 2025

Number 56 Wedding Anniversary today!

We had eggs and toast this morning and filled the week's pills. Around 1130 we headed to Tinseltown to see Mission Impossible. Quite a move. Two hrs and 45 minutes + 25 min of ads for movies we will never go to. I had to close my eyes for some of them. After that, a visit to the rest room was a must.

Dinner at Texas Roadhouse and we have enough for tomorrows meal too.

We got a walk in at 630. Totally avoided any news so we wouldn't have to see the stupid waste of money Parade or the No Kings protests. I hope they all went on peacefully but that is just a pipe dream.

June 13 2025

We went out to Walmart and got me a night splint for my Planter Fasciites. I used it last night but took it off cause it bothered my ankle. Stretched out my foot in the morning and it felt pretty good.

Wore my regular sketchers since they feel better than my golf shoes. We played Chenoweth and I was on fire. Shot 79 with 2 missed birdie putts and four 3- putts. Could have really been low. Had a chip in birdie on #10. Good thing it went in cause my putts do not.

Had me wondering why God wanted me to break 80 today.

Holy crap is there a lot going on. Trump sending the Marines into LA, Israel bombing Iran, people being rounded up and deported. Even legal immigrants fearing for their safety.

Time for my prayer once again to St. Michael to cast Trump and his evil cronies into Hell.

<u>June 12 2025</u>

We got to the Y for the Thursday class. Christine is back and we got a good workout. We headed to Carolyn's to pick up the spare scooter she has there so we can take it to Jacob for a backup.

June 11 2025

We got to the Y for the Wednesday class. They have a sub for the summer and she mainly does a strength class with a little cardio. It was tough. Going to be a lot of weight reps and squatters. Ouch. Will be tough on everyone.

At 6pm, Keith and Vicky came over to sort out the Turfscape walk thru quotes. Big bucks. Going to be \$17K worth of landscaping work. Ouch!

Carolyn said Jacob gave her the July and August rent money to hold so that is good. He had 2700 in Pell money. He paid bills and 1700 for rent so he has more. Hope it it spent wisely.

I looked at the details of my Citi fraud dispute and called them to withdraw my dispute. Danbury Mint charge came thru as shimmering inst #2. No wonder I panicked. How stupid. Must be the name of the necklace?

June 10 2025

Out early to play Good Park with the Lockheed guys at 840am. I had my moments, just not enough of them. Good holes, then look up triples, a 4 putt and whatever. Shot 47-45 for 92. Hit it well when I stayed put over the ball. What a concept.

Got home early and did some HOA stuff, then off to Carraba's for dinner with Jane, Mel, and Joann. Mel gave Jane the rundown on his surgery. JoAnn gave us a rundown on all the grandkids. Lasagna was great!

Jacob still agonizing over rooming with Carlos. I held my ground and stayed with my recommendation that he stay by himself and get er done.

<u>June 9 2025</u>

We went to the Y this morning. Pretty easy class. Mary stayed for Yoga with Brenda and got home around 1230.

I prepped and printed some backup for tonights HOA Annual Meeting. Decided to give the team their props during introductions. Wonder how that will go.

The meeting was at 6pm and went well. We have 2 new board members Kelly Osborn and Vicky Bortz. Not sure why Vicky wants to be on the board at 80 plus, maybe 82. She wont be any help with my spreadsheets.

June 8 2025

Back to you know what today; cold and rainy. What is wrong with this picture. Been happening over and over all spring. We went to church and it was raining pretty good when we got out. Lucky we took in a small umbrella to keep our heads dry on the way out to the car.

Tried to get location sharing going. I was able to get sharing between our two phones and maybe Carolyns. Tried some more but even though I say share always it sends a link which says only good for an hour or a day? Gave up for now.

Carolyn paid Jacob's phone bill. Will find out if it got turned on later on when he gets out of work. So far it doesn't seem to be working.

We walked around 530 after the rain was gone. Kind of gloomy and 66.

Yesterday I got a text that there was a charge made for \$38 on my card and nothing was going on or yet to be delivered. I disputed it and my card was cancelled pretty darn quick. Better to be safe than sorry. Thinking back 1 day, we used it at subway (tap) and Lobys. Wonder if someplace we were at had a skimmer?

June 7 2025

Nice day. After we had breakfast, I got after the tub downstairs. I got a system. Spray walls, rinse walls, get in and scrub. Use the toothbrush on the shower doors. Takes about an hour.

Vicky stopped over and later took Mary to the Restoration shop. She ended up getting a cool wire bowl for \$4. Watched the Belmont races and got totally shut out. Lady Luck has moved elsewhere. It was such a crappy day they postponed 2 turf races till next week and made a mess of the betting.

Did some HOA stuff, took stuff to recycle and generally vegged.

Lot of texting with Jacob. His phone is still off but Carolyn will get it turned on tomorrow. Basically, he is having trouble overspending. Got himself into a mess with credit cards. He pays the minimum when due and they all 3 of them are maxed out. When his paycheck comes it is eaten with bills due.

He is hoping for his summer Fafsa money. Think he overspent expecting it to show up. But it was delayed since they kept trying to send it to his old bank. He seems to be really adept at screwing up time after time.

June 6 2025

Did not sleep well. Hot then cold then hot thing going on. Got up at 630 and cancelled golf. It was 50/50 flip a coin time. We could have played but were bound to get a little wet. Since it was a hr drive and I didn't sleep well, I called it off.

Spent most of the morning looking at the landscape work quote that we got. I think if we can postpone a few items, use some extra tree money, and use some reserves, we can fund most of it.

Watched the horses and did badly. Got our walk in later.

On the good news front, Jacob got his phone back on and was at work. Must be doing better.

June 5 2025

Took a casual drive to the doctors office for Mary's bloodwork. They have to check one item before giving the Prolia shot every 6 mo for Osteoporosis. They scheduled the shot for next Wednesday.

At 1pm we headed to the dentist for our 6 mo cleanings. Miracle of miracles, I had no cavities! Mary did not as usual. We picked up my pills at Walgreens and then had a pizza

flatbread at Lobys.

Carolyn and Jenna stopped in around 5 after bumming around the mall. They ate the food they bought at the food court and stayed awhile. Mary is always happy to have visitors and it really made her day.

Carolyn said Jacob missed 2 mo phone payments and they shut off his phone. I bet he will quickly take care of that tomorrow after getting paid.

June 4 2025

We went to the retiree lunch. Right outside in the sky were 3 Goodyear blimps flying by. I ran in and called them out to see. Pretty darn cool.

Good lunch. We got home and rested awhile before our walk. New neighbor was out so we stopped to say hi. OMG, he almost told us his entire life story. It was hard to get out of there.

Jacob asked us up around 3pm but I didn't see it till almost 430. We met him and Allie at 530. Got the wash started and headed to Panini's for dinner. What a disaster. We had to walk out after an hour. They were having kitchen help issues. If so, they should have told us instead of taking an order. We ended up at Canes for chicken.

Allie seemed nice and a help to Jacob. I am guessing she might be 20 or 21. Not sure what she sees in him though. In my opinion (Carolyn's too), Jacob isn't doing very good. Doesn't appear to be fully functional today. I have to get after him again but I am not optimistic.

June 3 2025

Did not sleep well but got enough. Common theme, eh?

We went to the Y. Christine had a sub while her lazix surgery settles. Much easier than her class for sure. We waited to see if Jacob would be up for a visit, but he never called. More on that later.

Took the bum taco sauce back to Acme and got a refund. Spent it on 2 Blizzards for \$7 with coupon. Had the scooter out in the sun, then tried to charge it. Nothing doing. Gave the scooter its last rights and stuck it in the garage. I will have to take it apart and get the lithium batteries to our hazardous waste facility. Down to 3 scooters now.

Wrapped up the HOA minutes and the packet for the annual meeting. Sent a note to Ken and Dick to thank them for their help. Sent another to Ron who is bailing this year. Can't say I blame him. He was a big help for the walk throughs and for keeping his eye on maintenance completions.

Called Rudy. Seems like he may get out today. He promised to call me back. He did call back and is back home and healing well. He was at his routine cardiologist appointment and complained about some symptom. Stress test and cath found blockage and he got it taken care of. Great move on his part. What a relief.

I saw Jacob's location seemed off so I asked Carolyn if she was with him. Turns out they were returning a phone to Jacob's troublemaker friend who was in the hospital. His friend had come over and was unresponsive, so they called for a bus and they hauled him to the hospital. OMG! How many need to die before the lightbulb turns on. Is there anybody in there? You have to say goodbye to these kinds of "friends" and move on.

June 2 2025 Posting #2

Dang Rudy; getting a bypass. He is doing fine according to the nurse I talked with yesterday. Got me reflecting on my vulnerability 10 years post bypass. Thats the average length people live after them. Hope I am above average. Too much to do and see. Got to take care of Mary, get Jacob and Jenna through school. See the kiddos grow up.

Guess I will get what I am going to get, eh?

Makes me reflect on life and all it's flaws. There were a lot of them; no perfection here. Throughout, all the family prayers have been answered except for getting the grandchildren to become close with God. I am sure some of it has been my fault. However, in the big picture, everyone has to answer for themselves, so it's really on them. I guess I have come to peace with that. We will keep praying and try for the best.

Dang Rudy. He is going to get an earful when I see him next time.

<u>June 2 2025</u>

Not sure why I did not post last night. Too Lazy?

Yesterday we went to church and then picked up a few items at Acme. Acme person paying out lottery tickets at best did not know what she was doing or at worst just cheated me. I checked before hand and I had \$200 in winners. She came up with \$110. I said no it was \$200. She went through the bunch again and found 2 that did not scan and then gave me \$260. I argued some more then gave up as she claimed she checked them twice. Fool me once. Next time I am going to fully document all of them before I go.

We got a walk in later in the day before it cooled down a bit.

Today, I played Ellsworth with Dick and Denny. Six 3 putts plus other short ones. Scored 90 but it was worthy of an 85. Edged Denny by a stroke coming back from 3 down on the back nine. Dick wasn't with it and was off. Shanked 3 in a row once. He was somewhere around 104.

Finally got a txt from Jacob. The quiet was worrisome. He says he is busy 24/7 with work and classes. May go up tomorrow if he is up at a reasonable hour.

Got a walk in with Mary later.

May 31 2025

Slept in a little since we had nothing scheduled for today. Eventually we got out for errands. Filled the Ford at BJs, picked up a few items there. Over to Walmart to return a coffee pot and pick up a few items.

Our pot was working but if you filled it for morning coffee, it would leak out 2 cups onto the counter. When I ordered a new one I must have hit the button twice. So I had to return one of them.

On the way back I remembered to pick up Mary's pills at Walgreens. When we got back, Carolyn called and wanted to discuss the wheelchair Jenna wanted. So I ordered an active wheelchair for her. The least I could do after all the help I have given to Jacob. Wasn't cheap but she did a lot of research on it and it seemed like a good fit.

No luck at Churchill again. The magic must be over.

<u>May 30 2025</u>

Up early again. I got over to Windmill Lakes and played well shooting an 85. JohnE edged me out at 84. Was a pleasure to play from the hybrid tees. JohnT was up and down shooting 93. Bill had some good holes and some bad ones at 104. We just finished before the rain. Just got hit by some sprinkles the last 3 holes. I was able to find some golf shoes my feet liked better so I purchased them and played with them.

Got my haircut after getting home. Mary held the fort and did a puzzle to keep busy on this crappy cold and rainy day.

Last night Rudy sent a note that he was getting a bypass. Jane wrote it was today. Kind of in the dark with so little info. Hope Rosemary gives us an update sooner than later.

We do know Rudy played golf Tuesday, so it must have been somewhat of an an emergency.

May 29 2025

Up early again. I got over to Arrowhead at 810am thinking tee time was 840. Turns out it was 908. Later today I realized a tee time for another day had stuck in my head. Geeze.

Played well on the front shooting a 6 over 41. Tallying up the feet of putts made on the front = 12 ft, an average of 1.3 ft. Pretty impressive, eh?

Jacob was wanting money for bills. I read him the riot act and only gave him \$32 for his PNC overdraft. He gets paid Friday so he can suffer the late dues on his phone till then. Let him know he is gonna be left hanging if he continues to overspend. He needs to learn.

<u>May 27 2025</u>

Up early again. We went to the Y for the tough class today. I took it easy, resting my sore leg and heels.

Jacob finally called a little after 1pm so we loaded the trunk and took him 2 scooters, water, cat litter, protein shakes, apple usb cables, and bandage wrap. Carlos was there and we went for tacos.

Got back at 4pm and got ready for the HOA Meeting. Kelly sat in once again. We went over the tree stuff and got that settled. Then we went over the info for the Annual Meeting handout.

<u>May 26 2025</u>

I was up early but did get a good sleep. Really zonked out last night. Mary slept in later and did even better. Early on I worked on comparing the tree quotes and passing them on to the property manager and the other 2 board members.

We had breakfast and got a nice walk in early. Then we vacuumed out the cars and cleaned the floor mats.

Terrible luck with my race picks. Caton was also out of luck as well.

Mary started the wash marathon. Had a bunch.

Jacob got back to us and wanted to get together tomorrow instead of today. We have been discussing his housing dilemma lately. His lease ends in August and only needs 6 months somewhere. Going to take some effort to find something suitable.

Txted him for quite awhile trying to get him to consider others in his decision making. Look out for yourself but don't mess up others lives just for your benefit.

<u>May 25 2025</u>

We went to 830 Mass with the visiting crew. I was surprised there were so many there. Perhaps more than 11am Mass. Very close. They enjoyed the kids taking up their family gifts.

They went back to the motel and checked out and picked up Dennis, who skipped Mass. They wanted to go for lunch before leaving. We offered pancakes or sandwiches to no avail.

We went to Rockne's. Everyone liked the food. Kim of course got some chunky mashed potatoes she couldn't eat.

We headed out and I lost at the races. Took our walk around 5 and that was the day. Thought Carolyn was going to stop by but not as of this 6pm posting.

May 24 2025

Mary went to Hartville with the crew and I stayed to clean the grill, outside table, etc. Took me a good while. Carolyn and Wes got here on time. The crew was a bit late getting here. Mary changed and we went to the Life Celebration for Kit next door and spoke briefly with Kevin, Daniel, and her brother.

Got back and we helped with the dinner. Everyone had a good time. The kids had a ball riding the scooters. Carolyn left at 5, Wes around 6, and the crew went back to the hotel around 8.

Great day.

<u>May 23 2025</u>

Posted early May 24. We were up early and straightened things out to get ready for visitors. Mary finished up the macaroni bowl with onions.

They got here at a little after 11am and we spent a couple hours touring the house and catching up. We served lunch around 1. Around 3pm they left to check in at their hotel.

Met later at Lobys at 530. The food was great. Erin stopped over to greet them and bought us an appetizer. We all walked out stuffed. Everyone came back here and they headed back out around 930. Long day.

The plan is for the cookout tomorrow at 1pm and 11am Mass on Sunday.

We got back, had tea, and then Mary started on the macaroni salad while I frosted the cake. The frosting job wasn't pretty but it's done. Mary quit on the macaroni salad at 9pm. Almost done except for the small bowl which needs some onion.

It was such a crappy day we cancelled golf tomorrow.

While Mary did the macaroni I worked on understanding the HOA budget actuals for last year to prep for the Annual meeting. About time, eh?

Finally, Jacob was scaring us again. He was broke and asking for money which is a red flag. He did overspend going to Cedar Point on Monday but not sure how he blew his whole \$450 paycheck already. He also added another class to grab some more Pell money. Hope he knows what he is doing but I seriously doubt it.

<u>May 21 2025</u>

Mary and I went to the Y. Pretty tame class today. Yesterday I had like 84 zone minutes, today 13. Much more cardio on Tues/Thurs.

At home, I had to clean some bird poop off the back glass door. Dang birds.

Jacob was txting me a lot last night and today. Worried about him all last night. He is unsure what to do this August about living quarters. He doesn't want to sign a years lease since he likely will graduate in January. They won't give him a month to month option. He is unsure about splitting rent with Carlos and can't afford his own place. Of course he wants a car (again).

Seems like he is taking too many Summer classes so he can get Pell money. Twelve credit hours seem like too much. straightened up and vacuumed.

Carolyn brought back the scooter Allie crashed on. Seems like the front wheel is bent? It does look that way. Jacob said it didn't run right. Carolyn says it runs OK though.

<u>May 20 2025</u>

Chilly day in the low 60s. We did the early Y class. Boy, that 8 lb weight feels like a 12 pounder after not lifting them for awhile.

We got home and straightened up and vacuumed. Wore us out. Rested a bit and then scrubbed the deck to get some of the green mold off. Gonna need to paint that deck again. It was done in 2021 but now has a lot of rust marks in addition to the mold.

We talked to Ruth. They are still coming Friday with Dave and Kim. Perhaps a cookout Saturday?

<u>May 19 2025</u>

Played Tannenhauf. It was chilly. Ken played well shooting a 93 for a net 63. I was up and down shooting 43-42=85. Made 2 long birdie putts and 2 was 50/50 on the short ones. Most missing on the low side.

Rudy brought me 3 round circles. I used one to apply an Allegheny State Park sticker to and hang it under Bonnie's picture. Looks great. Thanks Rudy!

Got Mary out for a short walk later. My right heel is giving me issues. Not sure why. Been like that for about a month.

<u>May 18 2025</u>

Not sure why I missed the blog last night. Likely due to wagering on the Preakness and then Churchill. Hit the last Preakness pick 5. Had 3 horses which made it extra exciting but the lowest payout barely squeaked by at the end. Hit the pick 4 at Churchill too but only cleared \$200 for the day.

If we go the church on Sunday, we can call them "Saturday Saturday" and "Sunday Sunday" as opposed to all the other days of the week which are basically all Saturdays. So today we got up and picked up a few items for Jacob and headed to Kent. Got there at 11:15 and made several calls and then just gave up and went home. He always has trouble getting up. Must have been up too late last night. Last time I am going there that early.

Wes and Carolyn took Mom out for Mother's Day lunch a week late since the crowds are nuts on the official day. We went to Texas Roadhouse and had a good time. I split the bill with Wes. Mary had a great time enjoying a few hours with them.

After dinner, we got our walk in.

Tried Belmont races but did terrible. At Churchill, missed the pick 5 race 4 buy a few lengths and ended up 4 out of 5. Bummer.

May 14 2025

We went to the Y for the first time this month. Been 14 days already. That made it difficult.

At noon, Keith and I walked with GP Tree to all the big tree work. Took about 40 min. We changed some of the tree work based on some of his opinions, so I made changes to my tree document. When I printed it for Tim so he could adjust his quote, I realized how poorly written the tree work was. Depended too much on verbal instructions. Thinking about it, it is embarrassing.

Jacob says his g friend Allie was all scraped up from a scooter wipe out. He feels bad for talking her into taking a ride.

Carolyn was over to watch Survivor in the evening.

<u>May 13 2025</u>

We were supposed to take Jacob to a Dr. appt but I checked before leaving and he said Allie would take him to that and to the dentist at 3pm. Was supposed to rain but it was only a light drizzle now and then. Radar looked OK, so we decided to wash the back windows.

<u>May 11 2025</u>

We headed to see Jacob at 1130 today. He was pretty tired and still had an exam to do today and started work at 3. We were going to go to Mikes Place but they were lined up. Mother's day! We decided to go for bagels. They were good and we dropped them off and got out of Dodge.

Almost got into an accident on the way home. We were headed home and waze wanted us off I76. I missed the innovation Way exit so got off at Arlington. It wanted me to back track but there was stalled traffic going the other way, so I just headed up Arlington. Well, waze was still trying to get us to turn around and it was driving me nuts. Spent most of the rest of the day on HOA documents for the Annual Meeting and was looking for evidence that we sent one owner a letter for the last 5 years. We were supposed to according to the walk thru documents but I only found 3 of the 5 in the digital archive. Time to contact the lawyer for our next move.

Poor sleep for both of us so we hope to catch up tonight.

<u>May 8 2025</u>

Forgot to mention I finished reading King Hancock last week. The book wasn't all that great, but I am glad I read it because I did learn a lot about him. He was one of the founding fathers that is mostly forgotten. He and Sam Adams were targets of capture in the first real battle of the war at Lexington and Concord., over 250 years ago.

When a youngster, his father died and he was sent to live with his well off uncle in Boston. When his uncle died he inherited the business and became a rich man. For years he played the middle ground in the British- American ongoing conflicts but eventually sided with the colonists when his business was impacted. Never lost a vote for any office in Massachusetts. Maybe it was all the parties he hosted for the both the rich and the common man in the area. He truly was the King of Massachusetts and locally was referred to as King Hancock.

He was mayor, governor, president of the Continental Congress. Don't think he wrote much of the Declaration of Independence, but he sure did sign it. May 6 2025

We slept in and skipped the Y today. Drove to Wayside to look at coffee tables. They had several nice ones but the were priced in the \$400 and above range. Maybe we will wait for a sale. Stopped at Walmart for a few grocery items.

Otherwise, we vegged.

<u>May 5 2025</u>

Good sleep and the rain finally stopped.

Headed to Good Park and played with the Monday group. Three 3 putts got me to 45 on the front. Was on a roll on the back till I hit a tree and it bounced OB. Saved a 9 though but it cost me a 45 on the back. Should have been around 87 but.....

Got home and we did our neighborhood walk. Mary held down the fort while I was gone.

<u>May 4 2025</u>

Since we did church yesterday, we vegged all morning.

We went over to Carolyn's and she drove to Kent to pick up Jacob after work. We went to

Men's warehouse in Tallmadge and found him a blue suit he liked. Bought it for him with a small portion of my Derby winnings. We got his laundry done and had some Canes chicken. It was pouring in Kent.

Finally got home a bit after 7pm. Long day.

<u>May 3 2025</u>

Great day. We got out to Acme early to get a few items and got rained on. It mostly rained all day long and was in the mid 50s. Major crappy day.

Mostly focused on handicapping Derby day. I never do any good on the big race days. Been doing good at Churchill by following Caton Brader's picks. I also respect Caleb Keller's handicapping too. Put in Caton's pick 6 and checked it against Caleb's but mostly stuck with hers. Also looked for important owners and jockeys and added Irad Ortize's horse in the 2nd leg.

Well Caton had 5 of the 6, and the one she missed I had added Irad's horse. Caton's #18 got it done in the Derby and I collected \$2062! Sweet!

We went to 4pm mass in case Wes needed me tomorrow but they found the culprit. It was a ballast in one of the basement florescent lamps. We were all dressed so we went to Mass anyway.

Bonus is when we found a 2 hr Benjamin Franklin on PBS from 2022. Got to find the rest of them now. Great day!

<u>May 2 2025</u>

Played Fox Den today. No one played well. I hit the ball decent but my putting was pathetic again. Thought I had that handled? Greens were too fast for me. Denny was having similar issues. Guess it gets in my head and I can't shake it. Anyway, shot 93 with perhaps 43 putts. Pathetic. Bill had issues on the back nine.

Got back and we went to Loby's and shared a Nacho salad with steak. It was really good. Played about \$100 in wagers at Churchill and came out \$35 to the good. Jockey Jose Ortiz has been golden for me this week.

Wes' electrical issues kept me up last night. Offered to come over today and tomorrow but he is considering Sunday. Guess it's not a priority. It would be for me. I would have taken a day off work to get to it. Kind of dangerous. I guess if you keep the right breakers off you are safe. That's pretty inconvenient though.

May 1 2025

Good riddance to April. Too many deaths.

We were up early and headed to Hartville to take care of the kids while Wes took Kaetchen for a screening which she needed a driver for. For some reason, they had an electrical smell with no breakers tripping. After considerable thought I figure it must be a wire that is possibly broken and overheating. They shut the power off and headed to the appointment.

We took Lincoln to school after a false start cause he forgot his back pack. We came back for it and then got him to school and brought Kalix to our house. Wes picked her up around 2pm. Called him later and they still didn't figure it out. They plan to clear out the smell and then turn 1 breaker at a time on. What a pain.

Mary and Kalix got a walk in after lunch and I played Churchill. Lost all the way to the last pick 5 and finally scored clearing a plus \$133 for the day.

Pretty stormy early evening so I figure cart path only tomorrow.

April 30 2025

We were up early and I was about to head to Kent when Jacob informed me he was going

to do the counseling session remote and not in person. So we decided to go to the Y class at 10. Mary stayed for the yoga class and Brenda brought her home.

Mostly vegged all day but I did get out and trim a shrub and pull a few weeds just to enjoy the sun and heat.

April 29 2025

We were up early and made it to the Y for todays beat down. It was tough, lots of reps. After class we picked up my prescription but Mary's was not there. Later on I found it was elsewhere at DrugMart for some unknown reason.

We went out to get Mary's prescription and had to travel over to ROs for a hot fudge sundae lunch. Boy was that good!

Had a good day at Churchill hitting the pick 5 for around 1k. Sweet!

April 28 2025

Forgot to post last night so I posted this morning for yesterday. Today I played at Chenoweth with Denny and Dick. I was on fire to start making 3 nice putts for par before missing one. Then it was a string of 10 bogies before finishing bogey triple par bogey bogey.

Got home and had dinner, then we did our walk. They got the potholes patched!

Jacob said he passed 3 of 5 so far and has an exam and presentation next week to complete the semester. Lots of work hours this week should help too.

April 27 2025

Forgot to post last night so I am posting in the morning. We went to church. Benson read the Bishops letter indicating several small city churches would be combined and be responsible to Father Bob. Surprising since he is a new priest and perhaps in his 60s.

Went over to Ace and picked up some screws for the scooter as a temp measure. They are too long but I put some washers on them to shorten the distance they go into the scooter post. My soldering fix got the scooter working, so I put the external battery on and it fully charged. Scooter restored!! Now they are all 4 are working again. Ordered some more screws and will replace the temps when they come.

Working on the scooter with my hands put them in a hurt. I used the arthritis cream several times including before going to bed. Seemed to help. I will get some on before heading to golf in an hour.

Texas Roadhouse for dinner around 230pm. Good timing and good meal. We put up the new umbrella we got for \$50 at Lowes the other day

April 26 2025

Busy today. Up early and we put away all the Easter stuff.

Got that done and started the scooter diagnostics. Took off the external battery and it charged to 100% That means the internal battery is good, and that is a relief! Those are hard to replace and are scarce. Been there and done that and they are a pain. Tried to ride it but got error 54.

Aha! Same error I got on this scooter when the connector pulled off after tire was replaced. Had I not put it on snug enough? Took the post off and found the wire had pulled off the connector. Must have been pretty bad when I plugged it in last time.

I added a 1 inch extension to the broken wire but could not do a proper solder since it was inside the pipe. Tacked it on the best I could and wrapped it. Not sure how it will hold up.

Then in my haste I put the handlebars on backward. In the process of removing the new screws, they both stripped. Had to use my extraction drills to take them out and now I need 2 new screws. The ones that came from china were just soft junk. To china I say

%#*&@ and then some.

We did our walk today and later on Vicky stopped over with some yellow cake. It was good. No luck at Churchill. Came close twice but the last leg of my pick 3s and pick 4s did me in.

April 25 2025

Last night Carolyn stopped over to watch Survivor. While they were watching, I fixed the sun shield for the outdoor swing which had blown off in the strong winds last Friday.

Also, forgot to mention that Kevin, who bought Tommy's place on the condo attached to us, stopped in and told us that Kit had been back and forth between the hospital and rehab lately had passed away. Yikes! That makes 2 over there. She had only moved in 9 months ago and did not spend more than 3 months inside and the other 6 months she was elsewhere with her problems.

Up at 730 to check the radar and it was a no go for golf. Rain was not going to clear out till 1130am so I cancelled.

Made a trip to Lowes to get a new toilet seat and outdoor umbrella. We found what we needed and a couple of other items plus a hanging basket. Never had a toilet seat crack before.

Pitiful wagering at Keenland and Oaklawn today. Not even close.

At Loby's. Erin told us her grandfather 94 passed away when we were there with Ginny and John last week. The funeral was yesterday. Holy Crap. That's now 3 within the last month. Two neighbors and Erin's grandpa.

April 24 2025

Last night I realized my drivers license had expired on my birthday. Got moving quick over to BMV to renew it around 9am. We then went to the Y class. Pretty brutal today. Picked up some water for Jacob and headed to Kent. The ramp to 76 was closed so we ended up going thru Akron to Tallmadge then to 261 to Kent. Added about 10 min to the trip.

We got the laundry into the washer and had breakfast at the Wild Goat. Their prices are pretty high. Breakfast was \$13. Ouch!

Got the laundry in the dryer and took Jacob to stat care for his rash. Picked up the wash and dropped him off. Stopped at Stricklands for a waffle cone and headed home.

April 23 2025

We went to the Y class. Pretty easy today. Took all the paper recycle to the church. Picked up one of my prescriptions, then vegged the rest of the day. Not even close at Keenland today. Quit after 2 pick 3s. Lots of upsets.

We finished up the ham from Easter. It was pretty darn good stuff.

Had the board meeting here at 6pm. Earned my pay. Found an error in Kare accounting that could have cost us \$4k in taxes. They will fix it and rework the taxes.

Carolyn and Tim were fixing her roof tonight. Had a hole from an animal to patch. She will come over tomorrow for Survivor.

April 22 2025

Got out the house in record time (45minutes IoI). Just made it to Mayfair in time to play with Chuck, Sam, Ray, a new guy, and one of the guys I worked with the last few years on VLA. Damned if I can recall his name right now. Disgusted with myself.

We played quickly. I shot 89 and was low by far with a 96 98 and 3 in the 100s.

Got home and got our nails cut at the foot dr. Feels really good right now. Then we got our

walk in as it was a nice day out.

April 21 2025

Oops. Looks like I missed 2 days. Saturday sister Catherine arrived. We fixed salad and spaghetti for dinner with Ginny and John also attending. Spent the evening chatting and watching Bob Ross paint.

Sunday we all went to 11am Mass. It was a very nice service. Carolyn started the dinner and the 5 of us were jolned by Wes Carolyn Jacob Steve and Kathy. We had plenty of leftovers and I sent Steve and Kathy home with a lot of ham.

Poor Steve. He now needs his 2 front teeth, having them yanked out last week. Everyone was gone by 830. We watched some antiques roadshow and went to bed at 10.

I had trouble getting to sleep with all the food on my stomach even though I stopped snacking around 6pm. Couple of times I thought I was gonna yak it all up but I hung in there.

Lots of rain today. Catherine headed to Buffalo at 930. Ginny and John stopped over at 1030 and hung for lunch. They headed to the airport at 2pm to catch a 530 flight. We got the dishes done and straightened up some of the Easter stuff during the afternoon. Got to catch up on some sleep. Playing Mayfair way too early tomorrow at 845 with the Lockheed guys. I would expect the Monday group at Chippewa got rained out.

April 18 2025

Great day. Played well at Mayfair shooting 86. Everyone else was at 100 or above.

Got back and went to Loby's with Ginny and John. Way too noisy there at 4pm. A real zoo.

They stayed till 830 and headed back to the motel. Should see them sometime tomorrow.

April 17 2025

Great day. Started cold but warmed into the 60s. We finally got back to the Y and survived our first class in a couple of weeks. I do have a few sore muscles but not unexpected.

After class we picked up razor blades for Jacob and headed to Kent. He got some wash done and we ate Chinese Buffet again. Picked up a nice cranberry dish at Einsteins Attic. People moved into Scott's old place today.

Struck out at Keenland today. Lots of favorites won so payoffs were low.

April 16 2025

Still cold 40s and windy with a nasty wind chill. Got an early call and got the Nest Destruction Permit from ODNR. Hope it is in time.

Mary had an eye dr. appt at 1:15. They ran $\frac{1}{2}$ hr late which was aggravating. Picked up some yogurt and some batteries. We vegged after that.

Did better at Keenland today. Missed only one race in the early pick 5. Damn 3/5 favorite was way back in second. Did hit the late pick 4 and doubled my money for the day.

April 15 2025

Back to cold and windy. Jenna brought over the new garbage disposal yesterday, I opened it up and found it had a plug instead of like the one I had which was direct wired. After much thought, I decided to put an outlet under the sink,

Went out and picked up a box. In order to put the box in, I had to pull out the crapped out disposal to have room to get in there and install the box. That was a chore crawling and reaching. It wasn't too bad though. Got out of there with nary a cramp.

Installing the new one on the sink fixture was easy as I used the old hanging drain fixture. First try I did not lock it in properly and it leaked. After I got it locked in, it took a couple of tries to stop the leaks at the output into the sink drain. Total time 1 hr 45 min. That doesn't include prep time, cleanup, nor the trip to the hardware store for the box.

Played Parx yesterday and today. Missed the last pick 4 race both days. Aggravating.

April 14 2025

It was a good day. Decent temperature too. We went to the funeral mass for Laura at ST Mary's in Massillon. Built in 1876 it is awesomely beautiful. It is a combined parish now with 3 other churches. One can only hope it survives. Looks like some repairs are needed and that is bad.

We stopped for a few items at Acme, had lunch, and vegged. I worked on a 2024 HOA highlight document for the annual meeting. We did get our walk in since it was nice out.

April 13 2025

It was a good day. We were up by 830 and wiped everything down to kill germs. Off to church for Palm Sunday. It ran a little long so we skipped out at 1210. Carolyn and Tim were moving mulch to the back already.

Wes got there with the gang around 1pm while Tim had just started the burgers and dogs. We ate then opened presents and then the crew tackled the mulch. They made quick work of it. There were 6 bags left so I had Wes take them home with him.

Carolyn and Tim headed out. Wes and the gang went down to Goose Poop Lake to stretch their legs. Everyone was gone by 4pm and the party was over.

Mary and I watched the end of the Masters and got ready to go to calling hours for Laura. They will be from 7 to 9 tonight. Long day.

There will be no Y, no golf, nor a Red Hat lunch with us going to the 11am funeral for Laura.

April 12 2025

We slept in and we both felt good this morning. I think I am at 90% with still a little drainage to deal with. Lets see how I am doing tomorrow.

Not much went on till we headed to Kent so see Jacob. Stopped at BJs for litter and met Jacob at 4pm. Got his laundry in the wash and then went to 176 Antique Mall to look around. I got Sue another chicken and some baskets. One for Catherine's Easter Basket.

Got the wash into the dryer and went for tacos in downtown Kent. Nice place, second time we ate there.

April 11 2025

Not a bad sleep but my fitbit said I was only 15% ready for the day. More mucus last night so I guess the germ fight has restarted. So far Mary is still healthy!

I laid low today and played Keenland with no luck. We did go out to pick up prescriptions and a couple of fish sandwiches, then back home to be shut ins,

I finished compiling the Maintenance walk thru items and sent the files out to the property manager and other board members. The property manager can get quotes and issue work orders now.

No response on the goose permit. That worries me a bit since Keith said it is usually quick. Maybe I checked the wrong boxes but I had to wing it since I had no guidance.

Going to visit Jacob tomorrow and then return for calling hours at the funeral home.. Hopefully he does not catch this cold.

April 10 2025

Tough time sleeping. Was thinking I had better get some stuff mailed out to the residents.

We need the proxy votes to make a quorum at the meeting. Slept till 830 so I did get 7 hrs in. Worked on 3 documents to send to the property manager and got it to him. Told him it needs to be mailed out by May 1.

Thought I was thru the cold but this morning I still had more congestion than I did last night so I took it easy again today. I would say I am at 80% and hope to improve by tomorrow.

Put together a folder on the Goose situation for the HOA while I am trying to get the permit for nest destruction. Then I continued to combine walk thru notes. I think I am past the halfway point.

Jacob made his first therapy appt today and has 3 more scheduled thru mid May. I hope to be able to take him to those and not be dealing with a physical problem like a cold or sciatica.

April 9 2025

Good thing I checked my emails. I had pushed the maintenance walk thru back an hour and a half but it didn't work for one guy so they all agreed to keep it at 11am. I had to quickly get dressed and ready for action. We started at 11 and ended around 2pm.

Wes stopped in to go to BJs and use our card to get some things for a work meeting. Mary went with him and I rested.

Jacob said he had a good day at work and was impressed with the other cooks and what they could do. Looks like this is his first time job in a first class kitchen. That is really good news.

April 8 2025

Last night I thought I was coming down with a cold and I was for sure. Lots of tissues last night. Went to bed early in an attempt to fight it off. Seems to have helped.

Tried to stay away from Mary and not give it to her. My guess is it was from the dance competition Saturday with all the filthy dirty little germ ridden school kids.

Had to cancel our trip to Kent, cancel our dinner with Rudy and Jane, and push back the maintenance walk tomorrow till it gets to be over 40 degrees.

Good grief. Can't seem to catch a break.

April 7 2025

Happy Birthday to me. We went to the Y and got a class in. After, we stopped and picked up some rutabaga for Easter and headed to BJs.

Filled up on gas then to the store to pick up lots of goodies and misc stuff. Thought I would be lucky with the lottery but that was not the case.

We got home and put away the groceries and vegged the rest of the day. I watched the Keenland races and put in a pick 4 that changed my luck for today. Paid out \$1100 on my \$30 ticket.

Jacob did his 2 classes and got a work schedule. There is a conflict Wednesday so he has to get that fixed. We will go up and take him for a haircut and have lunch there.

<u>April 5 2025</u>

Tough sleep again. Woke up to a call from Ron saying Barb next door had more garage issues. I told him he has to refer this stuff to the property manager. We can't handle 100 residents and solve their problems for them. Since it is a weekend there is no one to turn to. Told him he could authorize roto rooter if he felt it was an emergency. He decided to give Barb the option to wait till Monday or go ahead and risk paying it herself. That sucked up my first waking hour.

Then Jacob was frantic cause he had not slept and he wanted to sleep 2 hrs before his

work shift. Told him he would feel worse. Thankfully Carolyn had decided to head up there this morning so she was able to pry him out of bed and get him to work on time.

Finally got to do the pills. Mary wanted to know how to do it so we did it slowly and I wrote it down. Then Wes called and wanted to decide on the trip to the dance contest later (Kalix and Lincoln were in it). He had my car done at his local shop for \$358. Front brakes and rotors. Mr Tire wanted \$1200 for front and back. Really do not need back brakes anymore so the heck with those. Wes said the brakes worked well and braking did not make the Ford shake anymore. Sweet!

We went to the dance contest and were back home by 6pm. Long and stressful morning.

April 4 2025

Played Fox Den cart path only and that wore me out. Lots of wet spots and some waterlogged places. Ended up walking 3.2 miles on a sore heal. Just got to get some inserts for those golf shoes. We were exhausted.

Was ok with the driver and putting but topped quite a few irons and hybrids by not staying over the ball plus some look ups. That was disappointing. So was my wedge play. Everything was short.

We went for fish at St George's. It was good. We met Vicky and her daughter who paid her a surprise visit from Florida today.

Jacob was silent today. Always worry when that happens. Very unsettling. He has been getting a lot of hate text recently. We have told him countless times to block the haters and stop texting cause it just makes it worse. He never listens and just keeps getting more. Boy has no sense.

April 3 2025

Busy day. I got the driver shaft switched out with the one Bill loaned me. Washed out my trunk liner from some spilled detergent. Got the clubs in the trunk for tomorrow.

I saw Laura's brother out there so we exchanged phone numbers. I asked about the lung cancer. The doctors believe it was due to all the radiation she received during her 3x cancer recoveries, and even if they caught it early, there was nothing they could do about it. I did not know that could even happen. OMG she had a tough life.

At 1pm, I got my implant finished up (screwed in) and got a battery for the Toyota key fob. We went to Lobys for pizza. Got back and we got the scooter ready for a new tire. When Carolyn get here she almost got the tire on by herself. My hands just are not strong enough anymore. Scooter is up and running.

Jacob is working a long shift 3pm to 930pm. I will take the scooter back this weekend.

April 2 2025

Very poor sleep last night. Getting to be much too common. I was getting ready to head to Kent when Carolyn saved me and said she would do it. I went back to bed and got another 90 min sleep. Sure felt better after that.

Carolyn got Jacob to his Psychiatrist meeting and then to his work shift. He wanted to be weaned off of Prozac, and that is what they are going to do. Goes back in 2 weeks. I am a bit worried. Not going to be an easy transition.

Eye is still puffy but mostly better. We headed to the Hope Mission meeting. They had Refuse of Hope present. Wow do they do great work. They have 66 beds, provide lunch 4 days and dinner all week, have a walk in clinic, free clothes and spiritual counseling.

We hurried out of that to our doctors appointments. Those went well. We are mostly healthy.

Saw Laura's obit and wrote a note in the guest book. Calling hrs are April 13 with a funeral on the 14th.

April 1 2025

I was planning the HOA meeting and was informed neighbor Laura was already gone. Not surprised. The family likely compassionately pulled the plug. RIP Laura.

Eye is still puffy but slightly better. Stayed home and vegged. Did not to scare those at the Y.

Need to get to Kent early tomorrow to take Jacob to his Psych appointment and then get him to his work shift at the Bell Tower Brewery.

March 31 2025

Finally this miserable month is over. I did finally get a good night sleep by heading to bed at 9pm exhausted. Unfortunately all that sleep on one side of my face blocked some drainage and I had a very puffy right eye. I quickly got an eye Dr appt later in the day and he suggested warm cloths 2x a day. He said to apply heat and massage the cheek. That is where the drainage channels reside.

Got the final bad news for the month and it was bad. News came that neighbor Laura wasn't coming home. She is now heavily sedated and incubated in the ICU with advanced lung cancer. All I can picture is seeing Mary's brother Jim in a similar situation the day before the plug was pulled on the respirator. I still can't talk about it without breaking up even though it was a few years ago. Worst thing I had ever seen.

Jacob is doing OK. Carolyn thinks he might have just taken some Xanax and needed to sleep it off. He has work shifts Wednesday thru Sunday totaling 22.5 hrs so he won't be totally broke anymore. That was really weighing on him.

March 30 2025

Another tough sleep night, 3 in a row now. We had breakfast and went to church. Stopped at Acme to get some frosting for the cake we made for Kalix yesterday. Picked up some other stuff too. No news on a party day or time.

Rain most of the day kept us in.

Jacob was txting me last night about possible moves ahead. Told him to get his degree, a job, and the insurance that goes with a good job. He will be off dad's in a year and will need is own. He kind of went silent today so not sure what he is up to. The added stress is not good.

March 29 2025

Tough sleep night but by 845am, I had my 7 hrs in. We had breakfast and went to HD to pick up mulch. Poor kid there was loading cars and trucks by himself. He will sleep good tonight. We made 2 trips for our 32 cu ft. We stacked them in the garage for whenever the mulch party is.

Saw Vicky walking. She stopped for a bit and we made plans for next Friday fish fry. We did head out on our own walk just to enjoy the warm weather.

Glad we saved the pirogi from last night. It went good with our left over tacos for dinner.

Jacob worked his second day shift at the Bell Tower Brewing Company. Sounds like he likes it there. It's in an old church in Kent.

March 28 2025

We got the Easter decorations out and cleaned the guest room up. Got the baskets out and decorated.

Went to St Joe's for fish dinner. They give you a ton of food but I have had better fried fish. The church was closed, so we did not get to see it.

Jacob has more scooter problems. Sounds like the battery.

March 27 2025

Decided to skip the Y one more time and let the body heal a bit more. Checked with Jacob and he was free, so we went up and dropped off the scooter I had replaced the tire on and took his to replace the worn tire on that. So he has the first unit purchased and I now have the refurbished unit purchased directly from Segway as a backup.

We went for Taco's and they were good. Steve missed out again; he claimed not enough notice.

The dog walker was over at Laura's. We went over and asked how she was doing. She didn't know other than Laura had a collapsed lung and they had 13 people waiting on a hospital room.

March 26 2025

Weird day. Yesterday I txt neighbor and board member Laura and she said her sister in law arrived and took her to the ER because of her breathing problems. This morning she said she was waiting for a bed in the hospital while in the ER. They want to look at her lungs so that isn't a good omen.

Then an ambulance came and stopped 3 driveways away and they put someone in a stretcher and hauled them out of here. Later on we helped with a funeral lunch.

Carolyn stopped over for Survivor. She was late because she had a brush fire in her yard and the fire department was out to put it out. Neighbor is gonna be in trouble since there is a no fire ban in effect.

March 25 2025

Had some real pain inside thigh to knee from my groin pain. Worse than usual. Been bugging me for 2 weeks now. Decided to skip Y, rest, and take ibuprofen. Good move. Felt better as the day went on. Hopeful for tomorrow.

We went to Walmart for food and some items for the Hope Mission next month. We are donating to Refuge of Hope. Found 2 pair of shorts for \$30 and some clearance shirts for St Patricks day. Got back and rested and felt improved all day.

Got a call for a funeral tomorrow. We will do that at 11:30.

Jacob got a job offer today! Great news.

March 24 2025

Forgot to post yesterday. Yesterday we went to see Jacob. I took the Ford to Wes so he could drop it off and get the brakes done. Wes went up to Kent with us. We saw the apartment, did the laundry, and had the Chinese buffet. Looked at the scooter. I will have to exchange scooters and replace the tire on his. It is worn bare. 60 Minutes was late due to the basketball and before we know it, it was past bedtime.

Today we did the Y. My sciatica is still an issue but I struggled through it. Vegged the rest of the day watching the stock market have an up day for a change. We did work on the puzzle as well. We are getting close on that.

Carolyn called about changing insurance. It was a no brained saving \$600.

March 22 2025

I got 9 hrs and 45 min of sleep last night. I was exhausted after 2 nights hounded with sciatica. Was in bed for 12 hrs though. It was great!

We got ready and went to a funeral for Mike Sullivan, an old neighbor who lived close by in Uniontown. It was held at Holy Spirit where Lockheed golf buddy Chuck Ivan is a Deacon. I made sure to go up for a blessing from him; told him I couldn't pass that up.

Talked to 2 of the kids. one was in Carolyn's classes. Brenda and Pat from the hood also went. Brenda drove.

I got to calling my sciatica pain – the trump pain. It mostly occurs in the right side of my ass, so it is a pain in my ass just like Trump. I told Brenda that and she went on and on for 10 minutes ranting about him. She said if we had had a neighbor like him, we would have run him out of town. Like me, she also believes he is indeed the devil himself.

March 21 2025

Another Zombie day with only 5 hrs sleep. Sciatica kept me up again. To add to that, the furnace wasn't working properly. It was on but the blower wasn't pushing the air thru the house. Eventually, I had the thought that the filter might be the problem. I pulled it out and things went back to normal.

We went out to pick up some stuff for Jacob, get a new furnace filter, and find something for Kalix birthday. We got a merv 8 filter for large particles only. The merv 12 for large medium and small particles was holding the air back (my thought). It worked great.

We went to Troy's Toy store. Wow. Never seen so many lego items. We ended up getting a gift certificate cause it was just too much to pick from. I pity the fool that takes her there to look around. May take hours.

Got myself some salon patches. Seemed to work for a couple of hours so I hope I can sleep tonight.

Checked with neighbor Laura who has been having trouble with O2 with a virus. They did a CT scan and now want to look into her lungs and do a brain PET scan. None of that sounds good.

March 20 2025

Finally caught on that my blog dates were off, so I renumbered back to Sunday. Not sure why I did not post last Saturday?

Zombie day with only 5 hrs sleep. Sciatica kept me up. Finally had to take 2 Aleve at 2 in the morning. We were fasting and headed to the doctors for a blood draw at 10am. Picked up a donut for breakfast.

At 1pm I went over and the dentist scanned my mouth with a wand to get a computer model of my teeth. No more goopy impressions. Pretty cool software needed for the free hand scanning of the mouth. Has to match up each movement with something already recorded and append to that. I should have the final implant in 2 weeks.

I tried napping but had no luck. Tonight I will start with the Aleve.

March 19 2025

We did the Y class today. My sciatica wasn't too bad but it was noticeable. Mary stayed for the yoga class and went to Swensons with Brenda. When Mary got home, we went to pick up prescriptions and buy some coffee and a few other items.

I researched the rodent deterrent and sent it to the HOA manager. They sell metal strips you put under the bottom of your siding to keep them from getting in under the siding. About \$400 for 160 linear ft. Installation labor would be at least \$1000 I would guess. I had proposed this for one unit owner that is having issues.

Checked with Jacob today. He is still spending too much and running up his credit card balance. Unsustainable. I was giving him a talking to, being careful not to depress him about his situation. Sounded like his team was doing great in his Business Consulting class. His team of 8 is trying to bring a family restaurant into this Century and improve their business.

March 18 2025

I was off to play Sable Creek this morning while Mary held down the fort and did some laundry.

It was only 40 degrees at the start and everyone struggled the first few holes. I came alive

and finished the front 6 over after being 5 over after 3. Two birdies and a par helped. On the back I had 4 pars but a 6 on a par 3 kept me at 43 on the back for an 85 total. Denny was at 94 Bill 100 and Dick at 101. We did play quickly. I remembered my iron swing and to follow thru with my putting stroke rather than slapping at it. That got me on track. Still struggling with the hybrids though.

Wes said his guy could do my front brakes and rotors for \$300. Sweet. Jacob had his interview yesterday and a doctor appt today. Finally got to see a Psychiatrist.

Had the HOA meeting today. It went pretty smooth. Laura finally made the meeting via a phone call. She has some virus so I did not want her here. She couldn't get Teams working so she just called via phone and was just on the audio.

March 17 2025

We wore our green to the Y. I had to go easy today. Groin and hip pain, so I skipped a couple of the exercises. Afterwards we went to Acme for a couple of items.

Around 1pm I went to Mr Tire to get an estimate on brakes. The Ford has had a little front end shake when the brakes are applied, but it seems worse lately, especially at high speeds. I think the rotors may be warped. The guy there said yeah, it would be more noticeable at higher speeds.

Their quote was crazy. \$1100 for front and back including rotors and drums. Their part prices were almost double what I saw at Autozone. The good news is he said my front end was solid. They had all the parts and tires in the green too. \$1100 is nuts if everything is in the green? Wes said his guy can do the front for \$300. Sweet.

Got back and I put out the new solar path lights. They look good.

Jacob had an interview at Steak-eeze in Kent. Didn't seem too enthused. He has another on Thursday.

March 16 2025

Storms all day long. We were up and moving early. Picked up Jacob at 930am and we went to the Great Lakes Science Center. I thought it was an OK place. Jacob enjoyed it. There was a lot there for kids and a lot for adults. The adult stuff was pretty complicated stuff though. Lots of hands on stuff but they didn't really have much explanation for what you were seeing.

We stayed about 3 hrs then found an Olive Garden for dinner on the way home. We got back around 430pm.

Jacob has a couple of job interviews this week. Hope they work out.

March 14 2025

Another beautiful day! Played an ugly round at Sable Creek. Front nine was worse 48 with 2 water balls. Remembered all my bad habits. On the back nine, I steadied but poor putting kept me at 45. Putting sadly cost me 6 on the back. Kept blowing it by the hole too far. Will try again Tuesday.

We went to Lobys for fish. Pretty busy there today as people are coming out of their hibernation. After a short rest we got out and walked.

<u>March 13 2025</u>

Another beautiful day! We went to the Y for the Tabata class. It was rough because I still had sore muscles from earlier this week. Got home and did a lot of groaning every time I got up.

After a short rest we went to Ollies to buy some good stuff cheap. Got lots of Easter candy and stuff. Also a nice suitcase for \$50 to replace the one that broke on our Savannah trip.

Going to go on a road trip Sunday. Great Lakes Science Center with Jacob.

Worked on a couple HOA things this afternoon. Another HOA Board meeting next Tuesday.

March 12 2025

Another beautiful day! We went to the Y. Mary stayed and Brenda brought her home after Yoga.

Around 2pm I went to the implant guy and they uncovered the implant screw so the regular guy can make me a tooth for the implant. Why the regular guy could not do that is beyond me.

We finished up some left overs for dinner. Wes sent some pics from Dayton where Z was doing the robotic competition. He said Z's team did not do well. Nothing new other than that.

March 11 2025

Another beautiful day! Played Fox Den with the boys. Had a smooth swing, stayed over the ball, made a good turn and hit it well. Even made a couple of putts! 41-43= 84 the first time out was very encouraging. Hope to keep on doing what I did today.

Mary was busy with the wash. I usually walk with her but today my heels are sore from being on my feet all day.

Picked up a Subway for dinner. The Subway place was hopping. I believe it is back in favor because of very reasonable prices.

Jacob got to the gym in his complex today. No luck in job hunting, but he did get an appointment in the Falls for a psychiatrist in 2 weeks.

"St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan Trump, and all his evil cronies, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen"

March 10 2025

Beautiful day! We went to the Y. Mary stayed for the yoga class with Brenda and then Brenda and her went to the Red Hat meeting at Rockne's. That's always good.

Jacob was up when I got back. Got his clothes out of the driver and later took a walk in the balmy temps. I think it was in the low 60s.

Carolyn picked him up after work and taking Don home from the car repair shop. His truck sounded like it was toast. Not sure if he will repair or just scrap it. Jacob is back in Kent tonight.

He is having a hard time getting an appointment at a Psychiatrist. Always has to leave messages. He needs his meds adjusted and they are the best ones to do it.

March 9 2025

The snow melted and it turned out to be a nice day. We did church, and settled in to watch the last 2 episodes of Zero Day on Netflix. We watched the first 4 last night. Excellent!

Vicky stopped over for almost an hour so we had to watch the last 40 min after she left. After the show we did our walk.

Surprise surprise, Carolyn stopped in and dropped off Jacob for the night. He was supposed to stay at Don's tonight but apparently had forgotten and was in no shape to host a guest; having consumed too much alcohol. I don't know what else can say other than wow.

Took another look at Jacob's finances and pointed out some mistakes he made this week. I am going to stay on top of this every week till he gets the hang of it and stops screwing up. Reminded him he needs to freeze his credit and cancel one account. He continued his online job hunting. Needs one very soon.

Tomorrow is yet another day.

March 8 2025

Oh my, we got 4-5 inches of wet snow last night. It didn't stick on the roads though. We had nothing on the agenda so we went with some cleaning. I scrubbed out the tub which did not get much attention with our colds and Mary's foot issues lately. BTW, her foot is good as new, but we check it every couple of days.

Mary got some wash done and we will cook spaghetti later tonight.

I did not sleep very well and was up early sending Jacob some pointers on his financial duties. He is still learning about the dangers of credit cards and how to handle them. Need a job very soon and he is looking.

He found a missed reminder to complete his FASFA for next semester and schedule classes. He did get the FASFA in. Better late than never. Hopefully he will be able to schedule the fall classes he needs to graduate in December. Might be difficult as it is spring break next week. Not sure if he will spend the next few days here as of yet.

Was thinking last night about the fact that no one asks for our help anymore. Guess it's because we are getting old and feeble. I can see why a lot of old people volunteer often. Still want to do some worthwhile things. Not wanting to just sit in a chair all day and waste away.

Jacob said he went on a scooter ride with Carlos. We hope he is going to be a good influence on him.

<u>March 6 2025</u>

Not much going today. Jacob did some school work, looked for jobs, and hung out till Carolyn got off work, then headed back to Kent for a few days. I expect he will be back soon, as it's spring break next week.

I worked on a few items for the HOA. Working on a letter encouraging people to sign up for the board. Board members are elected in June but we need to work on people ahead of that.

<u>March 5 2025</u>

We got going on the cheesy potato at 930 and they were done early. Jacob went to the rec center for an hour.

At noon we went to church for ashes and then to the Hope Mission meeting at 1pm. Many came over with questions about if the potato was frozen and we sent the recipe to one person who asked. Everyone brought their favorite prayer and there were discussion

groups of 5. Believe it or not, I volunteered to lead one group.

Carolyn stopped over on her way to an errand. They might do a short hike since it's really nice out.

March 3 2025

Not such a good sleep last night. Headed to the Y for the first time in 2 weeks. It was a good workout. Several said they missed us. Mary stayed for the yoga class with Brenda. She was bumming around with her till 4pm. Finally got Brenda her xmas gifts. The mechanical hound dog scared the crap out of her.

Both tax returns were accepted. So after I picked up some stamps I sent in their blood money. Will have to remember to have them hold more next IRA withdrawal.

Carolyn picked up Jacob and is bringing him here for 2 weeks. His class for Tuesday and Wednesday were canceled so he has nothing to do for 2 weeks. Maybe he can find some part time work to keep him busy.

<u>March 2 2025</u>

We both got a good 8 hr sleep last night. Headed to church and lit 2 candles. One for Bailey. Did some wash when we got home and put away some of the travel items that Carolyn had borrowed.

Finally finished my taxes and owe \$3100. Federal was accepted. Ohio should follow soon.

Carolyn will be traveling home today. She plans to pick Jacob up tomorrow and take him back to Kent.

February 27 2025

Jacob slept in till 11. Got him up and he took his laundry up. Then we started to replace the battery on his laptop.

Vicky called and asked us to watch Penny while she went to the stat care. She had a nasty bump or bite on her lower shin and wanted it to be looked at. Mary kept an eye on Penny.

We got stuck on the laptop because we did not have a screwdriver small enough to get a few screws out. Called the geek squad and got a 2pm appt to do it. The guy there was real nice. They couldn't promise to get it done in time but suggested we get a precision tool kit. That worked like a charm and we got it done. Charge was at 71% and the charger wouldn't charge it any higher. February 25 2025

Not a much of a happy birthday for Jacob. We did have cake and ice cream after dinner though. Beth took him to class at 4pm.

He is feeling poorly today. I helped him straighten out his finances this afternoon. We are almost done but there is more to do tomorrow. Always wondered how people get out of high school having no financial common sense. It's a travesty.

HOA Meeting starts in 15 min. Once that is over we can drive to Kent to pick him up after class. Long day.

February 24 2025

Got Jacob to class at 11am. Beth returned him here after his last class finished early. No worse for the wear.

We picked up a bunch of stuff at BJs and GE. First real grocery run since we got back. Then we whipped up some meatloaf and ate around 4pm. It was good.

Beth will take Jacob to Kent around 4pm for his late class. I will need to pick him up at 815 after the February HOA meeting.

February 23 2025

We did church online today. Jacob wasn't up to it so we stayed to keep an eye on him. He got a lot of hate mail blaming him for Bailey's OD. My take is the 5 stages of grief include anger and that is part of the process. Told him to block those people. Not going to go into any details in the blog. It's all very sad.

Carolyn's friend Beth went to Kent to give the family the car keys and brought back Jacob's cat. That should help. Also got him texting with a grief councilor which also helped.

I will take him up to Kent for class and Beth agreed to bring him back here after classes from 11 till 5 pm.

February 22 2025

Oh my. Carolyn was heading to Jamaica for the week early today, but called late last night asking if Jacob could stay here a few days. She said he was fine, but needed support. He got here sometime overnight and has not be up yet so we do not have any details as to what happened yesterday.

Carolyn called between flights and said his close friend Bailey OD and didn't make it. We will be helping guide him in dealing with his grief this week. Hope to get him back to Kent Monday thru Wednesday for classes and he can stay here the rest of the week. Perhaps get him signed up for grief counseling somewhere. That is my plan so far.

February 21 2025

Got a good sleep and was up at 7am. Not much doing today. Mary got the rest of the wash done and I decided to go to go get a haircut from the local guy.

We went to Lobys and the fish was good. The lady we usually sit by put a new zipper in my Fort Niagara jacket. Wasn't perfect but it got the job done. Amazing how the old metal zippers are so superior to the plastic junk they use these days. Bought them a drink, so it cost me around \$7 for the fix.

Mary started a squirrel puzzle. Wish it was in a cage though.

February 20 2025

Back home and very tired from not sleeping very good last night and getting up at 530 to catch the flight home. Flight was good and on time. Carolyn picked us up and went back to work.

After unpacking Mary has been busy with the laundry. I have been dozing off, reading the mail, etc, but am mostly zombie like all day.

Found the Sketcher store and got me some new shoes and Mary too. My regular shoes have no tread on them and were dangerous in the snow, so I needed something safer. Not sure I will have room for the old ones on the way back. We picked up a small tote to help with packing and Mary got a new Michael Kors purse. It's a little on the small side but should work most of the time.

Watched the market. My stocks were down today. Looking for a place to eat, I found a

menu to Sweet Potato Kitchen. Looked diverse so we went there. Great choice! We had homemade pot roast and it sure was good.

In a half an hour or so, we will hit the hot tub one more time, then shower and pack up for a 6am departure for the airport. Nasty weather so there many be some long delays tomorrow. Hope not.

February 18 2025

Was much nicer than projected. Got up to 60 and we just had light jackets on. Wasn't sure what to do today. After breakfast decided to go to Old Fort Jackson. First built under Jefferson to protect the coast, and updated for the war of 1812 then again for the civil war. A small outfit runs it with a skeleton crew. Not very impressive but it was interesting enough.

Next we went to town to see the city market shops. It was very nice. We did find cookies and fudge and had a large chicken salad for lunch. It was very good. Decided to skip the railroad museum as we were pretty tired by then. Every day we poop out earlier than the last day. Tomorrow may be a bust with rain. We shall see.

Not sure how we gonna eat all that fudge. I hope we find room for it to pack and take home.

My stocks were up again today. God provides for those in need. Makes me wonder what my need will be. Hope it is to help others.

February 17 2025

Was great to see JohnT, Mel, Joann, and the Webbers. We were all in close to the end. The last 30 numbers. With the sideboard numbers I had 5 chances out of 30 to win something. Our name went out at #25 and my other numbers went out quickly. Just my luck. Mary did win a loaf of bread wen they called her birthday.

We made it home OK but not until 11pm. Long day with no luck.

February 7 2025
